SCHEDULE FOR AUGUST AND SEPTEMBER, 1980

(PLEASE -- NO PETS ON HIKES)

AUG 9 and 10. There will be three hikes this weekend. The first two are in the same area, so people who want to hike both of them may find it advisable to spend Saturday night in the area. Accommodations are available at Potawatomi Inn in Pokagon State Park, and at numerous motels in the Angola area.

(1) (SATURDAY) POKAGON TRAIL - Trail is located in Pokagon State Park (entrance fee) off I-69 at SR 727 exit. Allow 3-1/2 hours driving time. Meet at Nature Center for moderate 8 mile hike starting at 10:00 AM. Bring trail lunch and water. Insect repellent may be needed for crossing a marshy area. Patch and medal will be available. Leaders: Chris & Charles Brunette (542-7846)

(2) (SUNDAY) CHIEF LITTLE TURTLE TRAIL - Trail is located at Anthony Wayne Scout Reservation. Allow 2-3/4 hours driving time. Take I-69 north, and exit at SR 4 West. Go into Ashley and turn right onto Grand Avenue. Drive north to 500-S. (This intersection is a four-way stop.). Turn right on 500-S and continue to Anthony Wayne Reservation on the left. Stay on main entrance road (which will jog right, then left past office) until you come to a stop sign. Turn right and follow signs to Little Turtle Camp parking area. This moderate hike of 10 miles will start at 9:00 AM. Bring trail lunch and water. You may wish to bring insect repellent as we will cross streams and marshy areas. Patch and medal will be available. Leaders: Chris & Charles Brunette (542-7846). NOTE: Those coming from Angola should allow approximately 1/2 hour driving time.

(3) (SUNDAY) SOUTH GROVE, RIVERSIDE PARK, AND LAKE INDY - Go west on 16th street to the first traffic light after the ball park. Turn north on East Riverside Drive and go two blocks to 18th Street. Meet in the parking lot of the golf course at 6:00 PM for an easy 4 mile "Cool Evening" hike. Leader: Tom Hill (784 2784)

AUG 17 MCCORMICK'S CREEK STATE PARK - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 67 south to Spencer. Turn east on SR 46 and go a few miles to the park entrance (entrance fee). Assemble in the parking area near Canyon Inn at 2:30 PM for 5 to 6 miles of moderate hiking. Leader: Bill Flora (898 0760).

AUG 23 and 24 There will be two hikes this weekend in the same area. People who want to hike both days will find motels in the Corydon area and camping at Squire Boone, Wyandotte Woods Recreation Area, etc.

(1) (SATURDAY) SQUIRE BOONE TRAIL - Allow 3 hours for this trip of about 140 miles. Take I-65 south to I-265 (exit 6). Turn right and go about 6-1/2 miles to I-64. Go west on I-64 about 16 miles to SR 135 (Corydon exit 105). Go south about 12 miles and follow Squire Boone Caverns signs to the left for 3 miles. Park in caverns area parking lot. Moderate to rugged hike of 10 miles will begin at 11:00 AM. Bring trail lunch and water. Patches will be available. Leader: Cliff Hoard (896 2129).

(2) (SUNDAY) HEMLOCK CLIFFS AND PIONEER MOTHERS AREA - Allow 3 hours for driving time. Take SR 37 south. Continue 1.8 miles south of the center of Grantsburg to a sign saying Hemlock Cliffs. (If you get to I-64, you have gone too far.) Turn right and go 2.6 miles to a fork in the road. Keep to the right on the gravel road and go 3.4 miles to a second "Y" where you will see Hemlock Cliffs sign. Keep right on the small paved road to the picnic area. Moderate hike of 7 miles will start at 11:00 AM. Bring trail lunch and water. On the way home from this hike, those who wish will reassemble at the Pioneer Mothers Roadside Park on the south side of Paoli for another 3 miles of hiking in the beautiful Memorial Forest. Leaders: Bob & Marge Begeman (359 4174)

AUG 31 UPPER FALL CREEK AND WOOLLENS GARDENS - Meet in the parking lot of AFNB bank at 5500 north Emerson at 1:30 PM. There will be an easy hike of 5 miles along Fall Creek and a longer hike of 8 miles which includes moderate hiking in Woollens Gardens. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (257 9437).

SEP 7 GREENFIELD PARKS - Meet at Riley Park on US 40 in Greenfield at the shelter near the swimming pool at 2:00 PM for an easy 6 to 7 mile hike. Leader: John Behrmann(462 9286)

SEP 11 (THURSDAY EVENING) ELECTION OF OFFICERS, BUSINESS MEETING & SOCIAL PROGRAM (For members and their invited guests only). Meet at 7:30 PM in Fellowship Hall of the Covenant Presbyterian Church at 2305 N. Kitley. Park in rear and enter from parking lot. (DIRECTIONS: Kitley is 6500 East, midway between Arlington and Shadeland. Get on 21st Street from either Arlington or Shadeland and go north on Kitley a couple of blocks to the second church on the right. There is a Lindner Ice Cream store on the northeast corner of Kitley and 21st St.). SEP 14 GLENDALE TO CIRCLE - There will be hikes of 9 miles and 18-19 miles. Those who wish to do shorter hike meet at parking lot on north side of Statehouse at 7:30 AM to be shuttled to Glendale. Those who want to take longer hike, assemble at Glendale Shopping Center in the lot on the east side of Rural at 8:00 AM. Bring trail lunch and water for picnic in University Park. SEP 21 FOUR LAKES HIKE - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the sign for Morgan-Monroe State Forest. Go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. Turn left into the forest, and then immediately turn right and go to the parking lot for Bryant Creek Lake. Bring trail lunch and water. Moderate to rugged hikes of 6 and 14 miles will start at 10:00 AM. Leaders: Ed Chambers (244 4554) and Peggy Franzen (546 3185). Short hike leader: Bill Larrison (359 7538). NOTE: Ed Chambers will be celebrating his 80th birthday on Sept 25th. Come and join us in wishing him well.

SEP 27 (SATURDAY) YELLOWWOOD TRAIL - Allow 1-1/2 hours for travel. Go south on SR 135 to Beanblossom. Turn left on the blacktop road opposite SR 45. Go 2.7 miles to the first gravel road on the right (Bear Wallow Road). Turn right and drive 0.9 miles to the top of the hill. Assemble at Trail Headquarters at 7:00 A.M. for a car shuttle. BE ON TIME There will be a registration fee. A patch is available for this rugged 20 mile hike. Bring trail lunch and water. Leader: Charles Brunette (542 7846)

SEP 28 LOWER PLEASANT RUN - Meet at 2:00 PM in the swimming pool parking lot Ellenberger Park, 5400 block of East St. Clair (a couple of blocks south of 10th St and Ritter). An easy hike of 6 miles. Leader: Lois Vincent (783 1941)

- OCT 4 and 5 (SATURDAY AND SUNDAY) BACKPACK IN HOOSIER NATIONAL FOREST - Be sure to contact Libby Moore (852 4717) for reservations and information about this backpack. Allow 2-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to Bloomington. Then follow SR 46 east to the intersection with SR 446. Turn right and go about 12 miles. About 1/2 mile past the Hardin Ridge sign you will come to Tower Road on the left. Turn left and go about a mile on Tower Road to the Horseman Camp. Meet there at 11:00 AM on Saturday.
- OCT 5 VERSAILLES STATE PARK - Allow about 2 hours driving time. Take I-74 southeast to the Greensburg exit. Then follow US 421 south to Versailles, and go east on US 50 about 2 miles to the park entrance (entrance fee). Follow the park road up the steep hill to the main picnic parking area. Meet at 1:00 PM for a moderate to rugged hike of about 6 miles. Leader: Bill Larrison (359 7538)
