SCHEDULE FOR DECEMBER 1980 AND JANUARY 1981

(PLEASE -- NO PETS ON HIKES)

- DEC 6 (SATURDAY) ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - (For members and their invited guests only).
PLACE: Covenant Presbyterian Church at 2305 N. Kitley. (DIRECTIONS: Kitley is 6500 east. Get on 21st street from either Arlington or Shadeland Ave. and go north on Kitley about three blocks to the second church on the right. There is a Lindner Ice Cream Store on the northeast corner of Kitley and 21st street).
ARRIVAL TIME: 6:00 PM. Our old-fashioned pitch-in dinner to start at 6:30 PM. Bring food according to the size of your family group, enough for healthy appetites - an entree, a covered dish or perhaps some dessert. We'll mix it all together on the buffet table. Bring your own plates and silverware. The club will furnish hot and cold drinks, and cups, napkins, and table cloths. Part of our evening program will be a concert by the "Deep Purple Swing Choir" of Ben Davis High School. Also Santa Claus has promised to make an appearance. (NOTE: PARK IN THE REAR OF THE CHURCH AND ENTER FROM THE PARKING LOT.)
- DEC 7 IRVINGTON HISTORICAL HIKE - Meet at the swimming pool-skating rink parking lot in Ellenberger Park. 5400 block of East St. Clair (south of 10th St and west of Ritter). Easy 6 mile hike will start at 1:30 PM. The leader will discuss some points of interest along the way. Leader: Pat Fox (897-8247)
- 14 GNAW BONE CAMP - Go south on SR 135 to Nashville. Follow 135 and 46 east of Nashville about 4 miles, and then turn south on SR 135. Watch for signs in about 2 miles to indicate camp entrance on the left. Assemble at 12:00 noon for about 6 to 7 miles of moderate hiking with some hills. Leader: Bill Larrison (359-7538)
- DEC 20 (SATURDAY) GEIST RESERVOIR - Take SR 67 northeast to Oaklondon. Turn left on Germantown/Oaklondon Road. Go 2.2 miles to the gravel access road to the Water Co. picnic grounds midway between 79th and 86th streets. (Watch for black and white sign on the left identifying this road.) Turn left and go 1/2 mile, going through the gate by the barn, and park at the picnic area. Meet at 1:00 PM for a 7 mile moderate hike. Leaders: Bob & Marge Begeman (359-4174)
- DEC 21 WASHINGTON PARK AND ZOO - Meet in the zoo parking lot, 3120 East 30th Street, at 4:00 PM for a short hike around Washington Park followed by an optional visit to the Zoo which will be decorated with lights for "CHRISTMAS AT THE ZOO". There will be an admission charge to the zoo. Leader: Nell Larrison (359-7538)
- DEC 28 EVENING WALK IN MERIDIAN-KESSLER NEIGHBORHOOD - Meet at 5:30 PM in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple (On Westfield Boulevard) just east of College, for an easy walk of about 6 miles. The leader will route the hike down the streets that are best decorated for the holidays. Bring a flashlight. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (257-9437)
- JAN 1 (THURSDAY) NEW YEAR'S DAY HIKE AT ARBUCKLE ACRES. Take I-74 west to the Brownsburg exit. Turn right (south) and go about a mile to the Arbuckle Acres Park on the right (just before the railroad tracks). Go to the end of the lane and park in the gravelled area. Easy hike of 5 miles to start at 1:30 PM. Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439)
- JAN 4 LOWER AND UPPER FALL CREEK - Meet in the parking lot of the AFNB branch bank at 5500 North Emerson Way at 12:00 Noon for easy to moderate hikes of 5, 10, and 12 miles. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562).

- JAN 10 (SATURDAY) SOUTH GROVE, COFFIN, AND RIVERSIDE GOLF COURSES. Go to the first traffic light west of the ball park on West 16th St. Turn north on East Riverside Drive and go 2 blocks to 18th street.
