- FEB 7 & 8 OVERNIGHT AT SPRING MILL STATE PARK - (For members and their invited guests only). Reservations for this event have been filled. For those attending, please bring flashlight for evening hike, and also swimming suit for indoor pool. Any further information please contact: Charles Brunette, 542 7846)
- FEB 8 WHITE RIVER AND CANAL - Meet in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple on Westfield Blvd, just east of College avenue, at 1:30 PM. You may wish to bring something to feed the ducks in the canal during these easy hikes of 4 and 8 miles. Leader: George MacLean (896 5769)
- FEB 15 FORT BENJAMIN HARRISON - Take SR 67 (Pendleton Pike) northeast to Post Road. Go north and turn left just past the railroad tracks, and park in the east lot of the Army Finance Center. These easy hikes of 6 miles and 9 or 10 miles will start at 1:00 PM. Leader: George Newhall (823 6534)
- FEB 16 (MON) PRESIDENT'S DAY HIKE WITH TOUR OF BENJAMIN HARRISON HOME - Meet at 1:00 PM for a 4 mile easy hike through Lockerbie Square and the "OLD NORTHSIDE" and a tour of President Harrison's home (admission fee: 75¢). Park along Lockerbie Street between East Street and Park Avenue. (Lockerbie is south of Michigan Street and north of New York Street). Leader: Alberta Neill (634 7672).
- FEB 21 (SAT) BRYANT CREEK HIKE - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the sign for Morgan-Monroe State Forest. Go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. Turn left into the forest and then immediately turn right and proceed to the parking area for Bryant Creek Lake. Meet at 10:30 AM for this 8 to 10 mile moderate hike. Bring trail lunch and drinking water. Leaders: Peggy Franzen (546 3185) and Ed Chambers (244 4554).
- FEB 22 EAGLE CREEK PARK - Go to the West 56th Street entrance of the park. This is east of the causeway. There will be an entrance fee. Meet in the parking lot on the right side of the road just past the gate house. Easy hike of 5 to 6 miles will start at 2:00 PM. Leader: Joe Lehman (297 1632)
- MAR 1 SPEEDWAY LEVEE AND THATCHER COMMUNITY HIKES - Take route of your choice to the 6200 block of West 10th Street. This is just east of I-465. Go north on Vinewood Drive 1/2 block to High School Road. Turn left and follow High School Road to Westwood Country Club, (1501 North High School Road). The SPEEDWAY LEVEE hike will start at 12:00 Noon and cover 4 miles. Leaders: Odie and Phyllis Cassetty (244 9913). The THATCHER COMMUNITY hike will start at 2:00 PM and will cover 6 miles. Leaders: Frank and Wilma Thompson (241 7154). NOTE: Both hikes will start from Westwood Country Club. The first will be done before the second starts. You can take both or either one.
- MAR 8 BUTLER UNIVERSITY AND TOWPATH - Meet in the parking lot that is east of the library on Sunset Avenue just south of 46th Street. This 6 to 7 mile easy hike will start at 1:30 PM. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251 0562).
- MAR 12 (THURSDAY) - GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETING AND CLUB SOCIAL. - (For members and their invited guests only). Meet at 7:30 PM in Fellowship Hall of the Covenant Presbyterian Church at 2305 N. Kitley. Park in rear and enter from the parking lot. (DIRECTIONS: Kitley is 6500 east, midway between Arlington and Shadeland. Get on 21st Street from either Arlington or Shadeland, and go north on Kitley a couple of blocks to the second church on the right. There is a Lindner Ice Cream Store on the northeast corner of Kitley and 21st street). One item of business at the General Assembly will be voting for approval

of the proposed revision of the Club Constitution, which was discussed at the last General Assembly. The business meeting will be followed by the evening's program. Bob Hosley recently vacationed just across the Canadian border in Ontario. He will share his experiences with us in a presentation: "Killarney - A hiker's Paradise". Refreshments will be served.

MAR 15 (TWO HIKE) (A). TEN O'CLOCK LINE TRAIL - Allow 2 hours driving time. Take SR 135 south to Nashville. Go west on SR 46 for 6 miles. Turn right at the Yellowwood State Forest sign. Go 3½ miles on the forest road and park on the left in parking area for the Ten O'Clock Line Trail. Meet at 8:30 AM SHARP!!; for a car shuttle. Bring trail lunch and drinking water for this rugged 16 mile hike. There will be a registration fee of \$1.00, of which 50¢ can be applied to the purchase of a patch, which will be available at Bear Wallow Trail Headquarters. Leader: George Newhall (823 6534).

(B) SOUTHEASTWAY PARK - Allow ¾ hour travel time from downtown. Take I-74 southeast to the Pleasant View exit. Turn left and go into town. Turn left at the "T" and go ½ mile to the bank parking lot. Easy hike of 5 to 6 miles will start at 2:00 PM. Leaders: Win and Mary Pulsifer (784 1835).

MAR 22 MARTIN COUNTY STATE FOREST - Allow two hours driving time from the south edge of Indianapolis. Take SR 37 south and US 50 west. The forest entrance is on the right side of the road about 3 miles east of Shoals. Assemble in the parking lot at 1:00 PM for an 8 mile easy to moderate hike. Leader: Ruth Schroeder (783 7543).

MAR 28 (SAT) LAUGHERY CREEK TRAIL - This easy 12 mile road hike goes from Friendship to Versailles State Park. Allow two hours travel time. Take I-74 southeast to the Greensburg exit. Then follow US 421 south to Versailles, and go east on US 50 about 2 miles to the park entrance. Park in area on right side of road before you get to the gate house. Meet at 10:00 AM SHARP!! for a car shuttle. Bring trail lunch and water. Patches are available. Leader: John Behrmann (462 9286).

MAR 29 SOUTHWESTWAY PARK - Take SR 37 south to Southport Road. Go west on Southport Road to Mann Road, then south to the park. Assemble in the golf course parking lot at 2:30 PM. for easy 4 mile hike. Leader: Joe Breimeir (787 8002). NOTE: Mann road is closed north of Southport Road.

APR 5 SHAKAMAK STATE PARK - Allow 2-1/2 hours for travel. Take I-70 west, SR 59 south, and SR 48 west to the park entrance. Possible entrance fee. Follow signs to beach parking area, and park near the shelter house. There will be a 6 mile hike primarily on roads in the Lake Kickapoo and Lake Lenape areas starting at 10:00 AM and a 5 mile easy to moderate hike primarily on trails in the Shakamak Lake area starting at 1:00 PM. People taking both hikes may leave lunches in their cars. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (257 9437)
