- DEC 5 (Saturday) ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - (For members and their invited guests only).
PLACE: Covenant Presbyterian Church at 2305 N. Kitley. DIRECTIONS: Kitley is 6500 east, midway between Arlington and Shadeland. Go north on Kitley from 21st street to the second church on the right. (park in the rear and enter from the parking lot).
ARRIVAL TIME: 6:00 PM. Our old-fashioned pitch-in dinner to start at 6:30 PM. Bring food to contribute according to the size of your family group, enough for healthy appetites - an entree, or a covered dish, or perhaps some dessert. We'll mix it together on the buffet table. Bring your own plates and silverware. The club will furnish hot and cold drinks, and cups, and napkins, and tablecloths. Our program in keeping with the season will feature the "SWEET ADELINES" choral group. There is good chance old Santa will appear sometime during the evening.
- DEC 6 (Sunday) BROWN COUNTY STATE PARK - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 135 south through Nashville to the park. There may be an admission fee. Go past the fire tower staying right at the "Y", go past the park office and park at the Nature Center. Meet at 8:30 AM for moderate to rugged hikes of 10 and 16-18 miles. Bring trail lunch and water. Leaders: Peggy & Heydon Franzen (546-3185).
- DEC 12 (Saturday) GEIST RESERVOIR - Go northeast on Fall Creek Road to 1/4 mile past the Sailing Club. Park on the north end of the causeway along the side of the road. Meet at 12:00 Noon for a moderate 9 mile hike. Leaders: Marge & Bob Begeman (359-4174)
- DEC 13 (Sunday) WASHINGTON PARK AND ZOO - Meet in the Zoo parking lot, 3120 East 30th street, at 4:00 PM for a short hike around Washington Park, followed by optional visit to the Zoo, which will be decorated with colored lights for "CHRISTMAS AT THE ZOO". There will be an admission charge which includes a ride on the Train. Leader: Nell Larrison (359-7538)
- DEC 20 (Sunday) ARBUCKLE ACRES - Take I-74 west to the Brownsburg exit. Turn right (south) and go about a mile to the Arbuckle Acres Park on the right - just before the railroad tracks. Go to the end of the lane and park in the graveled area. Easy hike of 5 to 6 miles to start at 1:30 PM. Leader: Hank Moore (852-4717).
- DEC 23 (Wednesday) GARFIELD PARK - Assemble in the parking lot beside the swimming pool at 10:30 AM for an easy 4 mile hike. Leader: Mary Pulsifer (784-1835).
- DEC 27 (Sunday) BUTLER UNIVERSITY AND TOWPATH - Meet in the parking lot that is east of the library on Sunset Avenue just south of 46th street. Easy hike of 7 miles to start at 1:00 PM. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562).
- JAN 1 (Friday) NEW YEAR'S DAY HIKE IN HOLLIDAY AND MARROTT PARKS - Let's Start the NEW YEAR of 1982 the "RIGHT WAY" by hiking with your friends in the Club. Meet at 1:30 PM in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple (on Westfield just east of College) for easy to moderate hikes of 5 and 8 miles. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (251-9078).
- JAN 3 (Sunday) WHITE RIVER AND CANAL - Meet in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple (on Westfield just east of College) at 1:30 PM. You may wish to bring something to feed the ducks during this easy hike of 5 to 6 miles. Leader: George MacLean (896-5769)

- JAN 6 (Wednesday) TWELFTH NIGHT HIKE AT BROAD RIPPLE PARK - Meet on Primrose Avenue just south of Broad Ripple Avenue. This is directly across the street from the Park entrance. (It is suggested that you park on Primrose or another nearby street rather than in the Park, in order to facilitate your leaving). There will be a 2 mile hike in the Park starting at 6:00 PM. BRING YOUR FLASHLIGHTS!! There will probably be a Twelfth Night tree burning ceremony in the park starting at 7:00 PM, however, as of the time this schedule is being published, the parks department has not yet made a firm decision. - JAN 9 (Saturday) UPPER AND LOWER PLEASANT RUN - Meet at 11:30 AM in the parking lot near the swimming pool/ice rink at Ellenberger Park, 5400 block of East St. Clair street, for easy hikes of 6 and 12 miles. Leaders: Lois Vincent (783-1941) and Marge Begeman (359 4174)
- JAN 10 (Sunday) SARAH SHANK GOLF COURSE AND BEECH GROVE PARK - Meet in the golf course parking lot at 2901 South Keystone (near the corner of Troy and Keystone) at 2:00 PM for an easy hike of about 4 miles. Leader: Joe Breimeir (787-8002)
- JAN 17 (Sunday) SOUTHEASTWAY PARK - Allow 3/4 hour travel time from downtown. Take I-74 southeast to the Pleasant View exit. Turn left and go into town. Turn left at the "T" and go 1/2 mile to the bank parking lot. Easy hike of 5 to 6 miles will start at 2:00 PM. Leaders: Win & Mary Pulsifer (784-1835)
- JAN 23 (Saturday) GREENFIELD HIKE - Take I-70 east to SR 9. Turn right (south) and go to the fourth stop light which is at Main Street (US 40). Turn left (east), and proceed to the first stop light. Once again turn left (north) and drive one block to the parking lot on the left. Meet at the shelter house (in Riley Park), at 1:30 PM for an easy hike of six miles. Leader: John Behrmann (232-1603).
- JAN 24 (Sunday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - There will be a \$2.00 per car entrance fee. If you wish to save money on the fee, you may form car pools in the parking lot at 5450 North Lafayette Road at about 1:30 PM. The hike itself will start at 2:00 PM. Use the 56th street entrance to the park (just east of the causeway). Meet in the parking lot on the right side of the road just past the gate house. Moderate hike of 5 miles. - JAN 27 (Wednesday) WILLOWBROOK HIKE - Take north Keystone to the Willowbrook Office Park which is on the east side of Keystone just north of 46th street. Park in the southeast corner of the parking lot that is behind the Indiana National Bank branch. Meet at 10:00 AM for an easy hike of 4 miles. Leader: Dorothy Field (253-7114).
- JAN 30 (Saturday) LOWER & UPPER FALL CREEK - Meet in the parking lot of the AFNB branch bank at 5500 north Emerson Way at 11:30 AM for easy to moderate hikes of 5, 10, and 12 or 13 miles. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562).
- JAN 31 (Sunday) LOCKERBIE SQUARE HIKE AND TOUR OF JAMES WHITCOMB RILEY HOME - Meet at 1:00 PM in front of the Riley Home, which is on Lockerbie street between East street and Park avenue. (Lockerbie street is south of Michigan street and north of New York street). Please park on the street (rather than in the lot). There will be an easy 2 mile hike followed by a tour of the Home.
