MEMORIES OF THE BANQUET - 130 members and guests celebrated 25 years of "Happiness - A Step at a Time" at the Lake Shore Country Club on April 17th. Pictures, clippings and souvenirs from 1957 were on exhibit, and these have now been assembled in binders and will be shown at General Assembly meetings, overnights, and other special events throughout the year. We also have a binder of pictures of the banquet itself, and all of you who were unable to attend can get a glimpse of the fun we had - the anniversary cake, and the entertainment.

JUN 12-13 (Saturday and Sunday). BACKPACK IN HICKORY RIDGE AREA - Allow 2-1/4 hours driving time. Take SR 37 south to SR 46. Go east through Bloomington, and turn right onto SR 446. (NOTE: As we go to press, there is construction at the intersection of 46 and 446, and you may have to follow a detour to get onto SR 446). Cross the Monroe Reservoir Causeway and go 4.3 miles farther. Turn left at the road just past the Maumee Boy Scout Reservation sign -- NOT the road directly across from the sign. Go about 6 miles to the fire tower parking area. Assemble at 10:00 A.M. We will go about 2 miles per day wearing packs, and do additional hiking from the campsite without packs. Bring swimming suits since we will be camping beside a large pond. Leader: Cliff Hoard (896-2129)

JUN 13 LIEBER STATE PARK - Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time. Take I-70 west to the exit for SR 243. Turn south and go to the park. Entrance fee. Assemble in the picnic parking lot, which is the left fork near the end of the road to the beach, at 1:00 PM for about 6 to 7 miles of easy hiking through a beautiful forest. JUN 16 (Wednesday) LOWER FALL CREEK EVENING HIKE - Meet at the Town and Country Shopping Center near Tuchman Cleaners, 4401 North Keystone, for an easy 5 mile hike starting at 6:00 PM. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562)

JUN 19 (Saturday) TIPPECANOE RIVER STATE PARK - Take US 421 north into SR 29, and take that north into US 35. Take US 35 north to the park on the right side of the road. There will be an admission fee. Pass the park office, turn right at the next road, and park in the fire tower (trailhead) parking area. There will be a moderate hike of approximately 7 miles or a rugged hike of approximately 17 miles. Assemble at 9:00 AM. Allow 2 to 2-1/2 hours driving time. Bring trail lunch and drinking water. Leader: Charles Brunette (542-7846).

JUN 20 (Sunday) AL WHITE TRAIL - Allow one hour travel time. Take SR 67 southwest past Mooresville and past the Centerbrook Drive-In Theater. Turn right at the next road. (There are a service station and a grocery there). Go west 2.6 miles to the old general store. Turn right and go 1.4 miles to the Boy Scout camp on the right. There will be a hiking fee of \$1.00 each. Patch is available. Meet at 2:00 PM for a moderate hike of 6 miles. In the event of warm weather we will be wading down the creek, so bring appropriate footwear. Leader: Tom Jordan (786-9958).

JUN 26 (Saturday) TRAIL WORK ON THE KNOBSTONE TRAIL - This is not a regular scheduled hike, and no mileage will be kept track of. This is a volunteer program on the part of anybody in the club interested in doing trail construction or maintenance work on the Knobstone Trail. If you are interested, please sign up with Pat Fox by JUNE 20th. Take I-65 south to the Salem exit at Scottsburg. Go west on SR 56. Turn left at the

sign for Elk Creek State Fishing Area. Assemble in the parking lot by the lake at Elk Creek at 8:00 AM. Tools and instructions will be provided at the site.

JUN 27 (Sunday) NOBSTONE TRAIL - (Leota to Elk Creek). Take I-65 south to the Salem exit at Scottsburg. Go west on SR 56. Turn left at the sign for Elk Creek State Fishing Area. Meet in the parking area by the lake at Elk Creek at 10:00 AM for a car shuttle. DO NOT BE LATE!! Bring trail lunch and water for this rugged hike of 7 miles. JUL 4 (Sunday) CANAL FROM BROAD RIPPLE TO BUTLER - Meet in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple (on Westfield just east of College) at 2:00 PM for an easy hike of 5 miles. Leader: Hank Moore (852-4717).

JUL 5-16 BACKPACK IN GLACIER-WATERTON INTERNATIONAL PEACE PARK. - This trip was described in an earlier schedule. It currently has a full roster. For information contact the leader: Linda Elliott (634-1842).

JUL 11 (Sunday) TURKEY RUN STATE PARK - Go west on US 36 to Rockville, north on US 41 about 8 miles, and east on SR 47 about 2 miles to the park entrance. There will be an entrance fee. Meet in the parking lot of the inn for a moderate hike of 5 to 6 miles starting at 2:30 PM. Leader: Win Pulsifer (784-1835).

JUL 18 (Sunday) WHITEWATER STATE PARK - Allow 2 hours for travel. Take US 52 to Rushville, then SR 44 east to Liberty, and SR 101 south to the park. There will be an entrance fee. Assemble in the beach parking lot at 10:30 AM for moderate to rugged 8 and 13 mile hikes. Bring trail lunch and drinking water. Leader: Fred Eckstein (996-2597).

JUL 22 (Thursday) GLENDAL NEIGHBORHOOD WALK - Meet at 9:30 AM in the north end of the Glendale Shopping Center parking lot that is on the east side of Rural (near 62nd Street). There will be an easy walk of 3 to 4 miles. Leader: Dorothy Field (253-7114).

JUL 24 (Saturday) ANNUAL CLUB PICNIC - (For members and their invited guests only).
PLACE: Southeastway Park. DIRECTIONS: Take I-74 southeast to the Pleasant View exit. Turn left and go into town. Turn left at the "T". Go 0.7 miles and follow the road to the right another 1.2 miles to the park entrance. Park in the area near Shelter "A". Bring food and drinks to contribute to our old fashioned PITCH-IN Dinner. We plan to eat at 1:30 PM, so plan to arrive an hour or so before then. Please protect your food from the heat by using ice chests. Bring your own table service, and perhaps a folding chair or two. We plan to do some hiking in the park, and there will be the usual games for all.

JUL 25 (Sunday) LOW GAP TRAIL - Allow 1-1/2 hours for travel. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign, and go about 4 miles to the Morgan-Monroe State Forest entrance. Turn left and continue about 5 miles to the fire tower parking area. Meet at 9:30 AM for a moderate to rugged hike of about 10 miles. Bring lunch and water. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (251-9078).

AUG 1 (Sunday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - There will be a \$2.00 per car entrance fee. If you wish to save money on the fee, you may form car pools in the parking lot at 5450 North Lafayette Road at about 1:30 PM. The hike itself will start at 2:00 PM. Use the West 56th Street entrance to the park (just east of the causeway). Meet in the parking lot on the right side of the road just past the gatehouse. Easy hike of 5 miles. Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717).
