- DEC 4 (Saturday) ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - (For members and their invited guests only)
PLACE: Covenant Presbyterian Church at 2305 N. Kitley. DIRECTIONS: Kitley is 6500 east, midway between Arlington and Shadeland. Go north on Kitley from 21st street to the second church on the right. (Park in the rear and enter from the parking lot). ARRIVAL TIME: 6:00 P.M. Our old-fashioned pitch-in dinner to start at 6:30 P.M. Bring food to contribute according to the size of your family group, enough for hearty appetites - an entree, or a covered dish, or perhaps some dessert or snacks. We'll mix it together on the buffet table. Bring your own plates and silverware. The club will furnish hot and cold drinks, cups, napkins, and tablecloths. A choral group from Scecina Memorial High School will entertain us with songs in the spirit of the season. Santa Claus will probably show up later in the evening.
- DEC 5 (Sunday) BROWN COUNTY STATE PARK - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 135 south through Nashville to the park. There may be an entrance fee. Go past the fire tower, stay right at the "Y", go past the park office, and park at the Nature Center. There will be two hikes; you may take either one or both. There will be a rugged 8 mile hike starting at 8:30 A.M., and a rugged 7 mile hike starting at 1:15 PM. Lunch will be eaten at the Nature Center between hikes. Leaders: Peggy & Heydon Franzen (546-3185). Bring trail lunch and water if you are taking both hikes.
- DEC 11 (Saturday) INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT HIKE - Take US 40 (West Washington street) west to High School Road. Turn left (south) and go to Pierson Drive, which goes along the north side of the airport. Turn right (west) and go 1/2 mile to the International Arrivals Building. Assemble in the parking lot at 12:00 Noon for an easy 9 to 11 mile hike around the airport. Leader: Ralph Chambers (241-1555).
- DEC 12 (Sunday) OLD NORTHSIDE HIKE WITH TOUR OF MORRIS-BUTLER HOUSE - Meet at 2:30 PM in front of the Morris-Butler house at 1204 north Park Avenue. Please park cars along the street rather than in the Morris-Butler parking lot. We will have a 3 mile walking tour of the Old Northside followed by a visit to the Morris-Butler House. Entrance fee is \$1.50 per adult and \$.50 per child under 12 years of age. If you wish, you may attend the Old Northside Candlelight Home Tour, which will be going on from 4:00 PM until 8:00 PM. Tickets for the Tour are available in advance for \$4.00 at the Morris-Butler House or at F. C. Tucker Realty. Tickets purchased at the door will be \$5.00. The Candlelight Tour fee includes the entrance fee for the Morris-Butler House and for several other houses. Leader: Alberta Neill (634-7672).
- DEC 19 (Sunday) WHITE RIVER AND CANAL - Meet in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple (on Westfield just east of College) at 2:00 PM for easy hikes of 4 and 6 miles. Leader: John V. Behrmann (232-1603).
- DEC 21 (Tuesday) GARFIELD PARK - Assemble in the parking lot beside the swimming pool at 10:30 AM for an easy 4 mile hike. Leaders: Win & Mary Pulsifer (784-1835).
- DEC 26 (Sunday) SAHM PARK - Take Allisonville Road north to 91st street. Turn right at the Park entrance. Park in the swimming pool parking area. Easy hike of 7 miles will start at 1:30 PM. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562).

- DEC 31 - JAN 1 (Friday and Saturday) NEW YEAR'S EVE BACKPACKING TRIP AT HEMLOCK CLIFFS - In the interest of safety, previous backpacking experience is strongly recommended, and approval by the trip leader is required. Therefore, you MUST contact Bob Begeman (359-4174). In the event of severe weather, the trip may be cancelled. Allow 3 hours driving time. Take SR 37 south. Continue to 1.8 miles south of the center of Grantsburg to a sign saying Hemlock Cliffs. (If you get to I-64, you have gone too far). Turn right and go 2.6 miles to a fork in the road. Keep to the right on the gravel road and go 3.4 miles to the second "Y" where you will see Hemlock Cliffs sign. Keep right on the small paved road to the picnic area. Meet at 1:00 PM. Leader: Bob Begeman (359-4174).
- JAN 2 (Sunday) SOUTHEASTWAY PARK - Take I-74 southeast to the Pleasant View exit. Turn left and go into town. Turn left at the "T". Go .7 mile and follow the road to the right another 1.2 miles to the park entrance. Meet by the shelter house at 2:00 PM for an easy 4 mile hike. Leaders: Win & Mary Pulsifer (784-1835)
- JAN 8 (Saturday) HOLLIDAY, MAROTT, AND BROAD RIPPLE PARKS. - Meet at 9:00 AM in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple (on Westfield just east of College) for easy to moderate hikes of 5, 7, and 10 miles. If hiking conditions are such that we are unable to finish at a reasonable hour for lunch, we will eat at McDonald's or Hardees before doing the last 3 miles. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (251-9078).
- JAN 9 (Sunday) SARAH SHANK GOLF COURSE AND BEECH GROVE PARK - Meet in the golf course parking lot at 2901 south Keystone (near the corner of Troy and Keystone), at 2:00 PM for an easy hike of about 5 miles. Leader: Joe Breimeir (787-8002).
- JAN 12 (Wednesday) WILLOWBROOK HIKE - Take north Keystone to the Willowbrook Office Park, which is on the east side of Keystone just north of 46th street. Park in the southeast corner of the parking lot that is behind the Indiana National branch bank. Meet at 10:00 AM for an easy hike of 4 miles. Leader: Dorothy Field (253-7114).
- JAN 16 (Sunday) ARBUCKLE ACRES - Take I-74 west to the Brownsburg exit. Turn right (south) and go about a mile to the Arbuckle Acres Park on the right side just before the railroad track. Go to the end of the lane and park in the graveled area. Easy hike of 4 to 5 miles to start at 2:00 PM. Leader: Hank Moore (852-4717).
- JAN 22 (Saturday) LOWER AND UPPER FALL CREEK - Meet in the parking lot of the AFNB branch bank at 5500 north Emerson Way at 11:30 AM for easy to moderate hikes of 5, 10, and possibly 13 miles. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562).
- JAN 23 (Sunday) DOWNTOWN INDY - Assemble in the parking lot on the north side of the State House at 1:30 PM for an easy hike of about 5 miles. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (251-9078).
- JAN 27 (Thursday) BROOKSIDE AND SPADES PARKS - Meet in the parking lot on the south side of the Community House in Brookside Park, 3500 Brookside Parkway. This is a few blocks west of 16th and Sherman Drive. Brookside Parkway becomes 16th street. Meet at 9:30 AM for an easy 4 mile hike. Leader: Marjorie Begeman (359-4174).
- JAN 30 (Sunday) GREENFIELD PARKS - An easy hike of 7 to 8 miles visiting the 5 parks in Greenfield. Hike will start at 1:30 PM at Riley Park swimming pool parking lot. Take I-70 east to SR 9, the Greenfield-Maxwell exit. Turn right on SR 9 and drive 3 blocks to 200 N. Turn left and proceed 7 blocks to 250 E. Turn right and drive 1.7 miles to the parking lot on the right. Leader: John V. Behrmann (232-1603).
- FEB 5 (Saturday) UPPER AND LOWER PLEASANT RUN - Meet at 11:30 AM in the parking lot near swimming pool/ice rink at Ellenberger Park, 5400 block of East St. Clair, for easy hikes of 5 & 12 miles. Leaders: Marge & Bob Begeman (359-4174).

FEB 6 (Sunday) WASHINGTON & DOUGLASS PARKS - Take north Keystone to the Willowbrook Office Park, which is on the east side of Keystone just north of 46th street. Park in the east end of the lot that is behind the Indiana National Bank branch. Meet at 1:30 PM for an easy hike of about 7 miles. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (251-9078).

PORCUPINE MOUNTAINS WILDERNESS STATE PARK - Linda Elliott (634-1842) will lead a trip in this park, which is in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, on June 26 to July 2, 1983. The terrain is rugged, and hiking distance will be 50 miles or more. The park limits group sizes to 10 to 12 persons, but if there is sufficient interest, we will plan on having 2 or more groups with different leaders and itineraries. In order to facilitate planning, you must make reservation by May 22, 1983 with Linda Elliott. In the interest of safety approval by the leader will be required. The board of directors has decided that mileage credit will be given for this trip. Priority for reservations will be as follows:

1. Persons who are already members at the time the announcement is made in the schedule, and their minor children.
2. Persons who become members after the announcement is made in the schedule, and their minor children.
3. Invited adult guests of members.

WASHINGTON STATE - Ken & Sylvia Retherford are offering us a leisure trip in Olympic National Park on July 24-29 and a more strenuous trip in Mount Rainier National Park on August 1-6, 1983. You may take either one or both. Group size for each trip will be restricted by the Parks to 10 persons in addition to the leaders. In the interest of safety, approval by the trip leaders is required. The trips are offered in conjunction with the Hoosier Chapter of the Sierra Club.
