"Follow the leader, who is in charge of the hike"

"You as adults are responsible for the behavior of your minor guests"

The board of directors of the Indianapolis Hiking Club wants to remind the members of the above recommendations which were made for the safety and benefit of people who are hiking as a group with a leader. There have been times recently when hikers have been lax in adhering to the above suggestions, and it has caused some problems.

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- FEB 5 (Saturday) UPPER AND LOWER PLEASANT RUN - Meet at 11:30 AM in the parking lot near the swimming pool & ice rink at Ellenberger Park, 5400 block of East St. Clair, for easy hikes of 5 & 12 miles. Leaders: Marge & Bob Begeman (359-4174)
- FEB 6 (Sunday) WASHINGTON & DOUGLASS PARKS - Take north Keystone to the Willowbrook Office Park, which is on the east side of Keystone just north of 46th street. Park in the east end of the lot that is behind the Indiana National Branch Bank. Meet at 1:30 PM for an easy hike of about 7 miles. Leader: Marsha Hutchins (251-9078).
- FEB 12 (Saturday) DEVINGTON TO GLENDALE - There will be a 4 mile westbound hike starting at 9:00 AM at the Devington Shopping Center at 46th and Arlington. Park on the west side of the lot. The hike back to Devington will be 11 miles. Hikers going one way are responsible for arranging their own transportation back to their cars. The 4 mile hike will end at the Glendale Shopping Center in the lot on the east side of Rural, so if you are going only one way make your plans to have your own transportation from that point. Bring lunch if you are going to take the long hike. Leaders: Chris and Charles Brunette. (542-7846)
- FEB 13 (Sunday) GEIST RESERVOIR - Go northeast on Fall Creek Road to 1/4th mile past the Sailing Club. Park on the north end of the causeway along the side of the road. Meet at 9:30 AM for a moderate 9 mile hike. Leaders: Marge & Bob Begeman (359-4174)
- FEB 19 (Saturday) BRYANT CREEK HIKE - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the sign for Morgan-Monroe State Forest. Go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. Turn left into the forest. Meet at the entrance to the Bryant Creek Lake picnic area at 10:30 AM for a 10 mile hike. Bring trail lunch & water. Leaders: Peg Franzen (546-3185) and Ed Chambers
- FEB 20 (Sunday) CANAL FROM BROAD RIPPLE TO BUTLER - Meet in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple on Westfield, just east of College Ave., at 2:00 PM for an easy hike of 6 miles. Leader: Hank Moore (852-4717).
- FEB 21 (Monday) "PRESIDENT'S DAY" EAGLE CREEK PARK - Use the west 56th Street entrance to the park, just east of the causeway. There will be a \$2.00 per car entrance fee. Meet in the parking lot on the right side of the road just past the gatehouse at 2:00 PM for an easy 5 mile hike. Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717)

Information for day hikers wishing to drive down and hike with the group. We will start the Saturday hike around 2:00 PM and the Sunday hike around 9:00 AM

- MAR 5 (Saturday) DEVINGTON CIRCLE HIKE - There will be a 6 mile moderate road hike starting at 9:30 AM from the Devington Shopping Center, 46th & Arlington. Meet on the west side of the parking lot. Leaders: Chris & Charles Brunette (542-7846)
- MAR 6 (Sunday) BUTLER UNIVERSITY AND TOWPATH - Meet in the parking lot that is east of the library on Sunset Avenue, just south of 46th Street. Easy hike of 7 miles to start at 1:00 PM. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562)
- MAR 8 (Tuesday) FALL CREEK - CANAL - WHITE RIVER HIKE - Meet at 9:30 AM for an easy 6 mile hike along the waterways. Meet at West 16th Street - Fall Creek City Park at the intersection of West 16th Street and Fall Creek Parkway, (just west of West Street) Approach the park from 16th Street. Leader: Marjorie Begeman (359-4174)
- MAR 10 (Thursday) GENERAL ASSEMBLY - (This is for members and their invited guests only) Meet at 7:30 PM in the Fellowship Hall of the Covenant Presbyterian Church at 2305 N. Kitley (Park in the rear and enter from the parking lot). DIRECTIONS: Kitley is 6500 east, midway between Arlington and Shadeland on 21st Street. Go north on Kitley from 21st to the second church on the right. There will be a business meeting, followed by the program for the evening. Douglas Clark, one of our new members, will present a talk and slide show on "HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT". Doug has much experience in the field and this is a subject of much interest to everybody at this time. Refreshments will be served.
- MAR 12 (Saturday) SOUTH GROVE, COFFIN AND RIVERSIDE GOLF COURSES. & RIVERSIDE PARK - Park in the lot of the Park Department Headquarters at 1426 West 29th Street. (NOTE: this street is one-way going east). Meet at 12:00 Noon for easy hikes of 4 and 8 miles. Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717).
- MAR 13 (Sunday) IUPUI - Go west on Michigan (one-way) from downtown past the School of Dentistry to Lansing Street. Turn left and go to New York Street (one-way east). Turn left again and enter the parking lot at the first entrance on the left. Assemble before 2:00 PM for an easy 5 to 6 mile hike. Leader: Joe Lehman (297-1632).
- MAR 19 (Saturday) THREE LAKE TRAIL - Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the sign for Morgan-Monroe State Forest, and go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. Turn left and continue about 5 miles to the fire tower parking area. Rugged hike of 10 to 11 miles will begin at 10:00 AM. Bring trail lunch and water. Leaders: Peg & Heydon Franzen (546-3185).
- MAR 20 (Sunday) SPEEDWAY LEVEE HIKE & THATCHER COMMUNITY HIKE - Take route of your choice to the 6200 block of West 10th Street. This is just east of I-465. Go north on Vinewood Drive one half block to High School Road. Turn left and follow High School Road to Westwood Country Club. The SPEEDWAY LEVEE HIKE will start at 12:00 Noon and cover 4 miles. Leaders: Odie and Phyllis Cassetty. THE THATCHER COMMUNITY HIKE will start at 2:00 PM and will cover 6 miles. Leaders: Frank & Wilma Thompson (241-7154). NOTE: Both hikes will start from Westwood Country Club. The first will be done before the second starts. You can take either one or both.
- MAR 26-27 (Saturday & Sunday) BACKPACK IN HOOSIER NATIONAL FOREST - If you are interested in going on this weekend backpack, please contact Marsha Hutchins (251-9078) for all the details.

- MAR 27 (Sunday) SOUTHWESTWAY PARK - Take SR 37 south to Southport Road. Go west on Southport Road to Mann Road. Turn left and go to the Park. Assemble in the golf course parking lot at 2:30 PM for an easy 4 mile hike. Leader: Joe Breimeir (787-8002).
- MAR 31 (Thursday) BACON SWAMP AND ARSENAL PARK - Go west from Keystone on 54th street about one block to the parking lot between Waffle House and Arsenal Savings. Please park close to the street away from the businesses. Meet at 10:00 AM for an easy hike of 4 to 5 miles. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562).
- APR 1 (Good Friday) CLARK STATE FOREST - Allow 2-1/2 hours for travel. Take I-65 south to the Henryville exit. Follow signs to the forest entrance, which is 1/2 mile north on US 31. Meet in the parking area of the campground. DO NOT DRIVE ACROSS THE INTERSTATE BRIDGE. Rugged and hilly hike of about 8 miles will begin at 11:00 AM. Bring trail lunch and water. Leaders: Peg & Heydon Franzen (546-3185). There is primitive camping at Clark State Forest and motels in the Hamburg area for those planning to take the Knobstone Trail hikes on Saturday and Sunday.
- APR 2 (Saturday) KNOBSTONE TRAIL - (Jackson Road Trailhead to New Chapel Trailhead). Allow 2-1/4 hours travel time from Indianapolis. Go south on I-65 to the Henryville exit. Go west on SR 160 for 5.6 miles. Turn right on New Chapel Road. Go north 1/2 mile to the New Chapel Trailhead parking area on the right. Meet at 9:30 AM. BE PROMPT DUE TO CAR SHUTTLE. Bring trail lunch and water for a 14 mile rugged hike. A pit stop at the Henryville rest stop is suggested. Leaders: Peg & Heydon Franzen (546-3185). See note above about camping & motels if you plan to stay over.
- APR 3 (Easter Sunday) KNOBSTONE TRAIL - (Jackson Road Trailhead to Deam Lake via Reed Road).
(A) Be prepared for MUD. Allow 2-3/4 hours travel time from Indianapolis. Take I-65 south to the Hamburg exit. Go west on SR 60 to Hamburg. Then continue west on SR 60 for five more miles. Turn right (north) at the Clark-Floyd Landfill sign. Stay on the asphalt road and go about 1-1/2 miles. At the "Y" turn left on Wilson Switch Road and go 0.6 miles (west) to the Deam Lake Trailhead parking area. Meet at 10:00 AM for a moderate hike of 10 miles. Bring trail lunch and water. Leaders: Peg & Heydon Franzen (546-3185).
- APR 3 (Easter Sunday) GARFIELD PARK - Assemble in the parking lot beside the swimming pool
(B) at 2:00 PM for an easy 4 mile hike. Leaders: Win & Mary Pulsifer (784-1835).
