A BRIEF REMINDER OF SOME OF THE CLUB'S OFFICIAL GUIDELINES:

1. The Leader should start the hike on time.
 2. Hikers should plan to arrive early enough to sign in and be ready to hike.
 3. The Leader is in charge of the hike, and the hikers should follow.
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- DEC 10 (Saturday) A. HICKORY RIDGE HIKING TRAIL - Allow 2-1/4 hours driving time. Take SR #37 south to SR #46. Go east through Bloomington and turn right onto SR #446. Cross the Monroe Reservoir causeway and go 4.3 miles further. Turn left at the road just past the Maumee Boy Scout Reservation sign. Go about 6 miles to the fire tower parking area. Assemble at 7:30 AM for a moderate 20 mile hike. Leader: Marjorie Begeman (359-4174).
- B. METAMORA CHRISTMAS HIKE - Allow 1-1/2 hours for travel. Take US 52 southeast to Metamora. Turn right, go into the town, and meet in the Whitewater Canal State Memorial parking lot on Clayborne Street. There will be an easy 4 mile hike starting at 2:30 PM. Leaders: Win & Mary Pulsifer (784-1835).
- DEC 11 (Sunday) THATCHER COMMUNITY LEVEE HIKE - Assemble at the Thatcher Community Center, 4649 West Vermont St., at 1:00 PM for moderate hikes of 5 and 8 miles. Leaders: Frank & Wilma Thompson (241-7154).
- 13 (Tuesday) WILLOWBROOK HIKE - Take North Keystone to the Willowbrook Office Park, which is on the east side of Keystone between 46th and 49th Streets. Park in the southeast corner of the parking lot that is behind the Indiana National branch bank. Meet at 9:30 AM for an easy 4 mile hike. Leader: Dorothy Field (253-7114).
- DEC 17 (Saturday) GALLAHUE VALLEY GIRL SCOUT CAMP - Allow 1-1/2 hours for travel. Take SR 135 south to Bean Blossom. Turn right on SR 45 and go to Trevlac, where you turn right over the railroad tracks. Continue on the gravel road to a "T" where you turn left and go a couple of miles to the camp. Assemble by the first barn on the right for a moderate to rugged hike of 7 miles starting at 9:30 AM. Leaders: Richard Akers (545-0877) and Betty Woodward (545-4480).
- DEC 18 (Sunday) CITY OF CARMEL HIKE - Meet near Woodland Theater at Keystone Square, 116th and Keystone (Highway 431) for an easy hike of 5 miles starting at 1:00 PM. Weather permitting, there will also be a 10 mile option. Leader: Jim Stern (844-3791).
- DEC 26 (Monday) TOWPATH-ART MUSEUM-BUTLER UNIVERSITY HIKE - Meet in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple for easy hikes of 5 miles and 9 to 10 miles starting at 8:30 AM. Leader: Ursula Breeding (359-8686).
- DEC 31, JAN 1 (Saturday and Sunday) NEW YEAR'S EVE BACKPACKING TRIP AT HEMLOCK CLIFFS - In the interest of safety, previous backpacking experience is strongly recommended, and approval by the trip leader is required. Therefore, you must contact Bob Begeman if you want to participate. In the event of severe weather, the trip may be cancelled. Allow 3 hours driving time. Take SR 37 south. About 4 to 5 miles south of English you will come to a new section of the highway in the Grantsburg area. Look for Union Chapel Road, which is the second road to the right. (If you get to I-64 you have

gone too far). Turn right on Union Chapel Road and go 2.6 miles to a fork. Keep to the right on the gravel road and go 3.4 miles to the second "Y" where you will see a Hemlock Cliffs sign. Keep right on the narrow paved road and park at the end. Meet at 1:00 PM. Leader: Bob Begeman (359-4174).

- JAN 1 (Sunday) SOUTH GROVE, COFFIN, AND RIVERSIDE GOLF COURSES AND RIVERSIDE PARK - Park in the lot of the Park Department Headquarters at 1426 West 29th Street. This is a one-way street going east. Meet at 1:30 PM for an easy hike of 8 miles. Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717).
- JAN 7 (Saturday) LOWER AND UPPER FALL CREEK - Meet in the parking lot of the AFNB branch bank at 5500 North Emerson Way at 9:30 AM for easy to moderate hikes of 5 and 10 miles. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562).
- JAN 8 (Sunday) ARBUCKLE ACRES - Take I-74 west to the Brownsburg exit. Turn right (south) and go about a mile to the Arbuckle Acres Park on the right just before the railroad tracks. Go to the end of the lane and park in the graveled area. Easy hike of 5 miles will start at 1:30 PM. Leader: Hank Moore (852-4717).
- JAN 10 (Tuesday) BROOKSIDE AND SPADES PARKS - Meet in the parking lot on the south side of the Community House in Brookside Park, 3500 Brookside Parkway. This is a few blocks west of 16th and Sherman Drive. Brookside Parkway becomes 16th Street. Meet at 9:30 AM for an easy 5 mile hike. Leader: Marjorie Begeman (359-4174).
- JAN 14 (Saturday) INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT HIKE - Take US 40 (West Washington Street) west to High School Road. Turn left (south) and go to Pierson Drive, which goes along the north side of the airport. Turn right (west) and go 1/2 mile to the International Arrivals Building. Assemble in the parking lot at 12:00 Noon for an easy hike of 10 miles around the airport. Leader: Ralph Chambers (241-1555).
- JAN 15 (Sunday) FALL CREEK - CANAL - WHITE RIVER HIKE - Meet at 9:30 AM for an easy hike along the waterways. Meet at West 16th Street-Fall Creek City Park at the intersection of West 16th Street and Fall Creek Parkway (just west of West Street). Approach the park from 16th Street. Hike will be 7 miles long. Leader: Marjorie Begeman (359-4174).
- JAN 21 (Saturday) GREENFIELD HIKE - An easy hike of 6 to 7 miles touring the south side of Greenfield, including the Greenfield Country Club golf course. Hike will start at 1:30 PM at Riley Park swimming pool parking lot. Take I-70 east to SR 9 (Greenfield-Maxwell exit). Turn right on SR 9 and drive three blocks to 200 N. Turn left and proceed seven blocks to 250E. Turn right and drive 1.7 miles to the parking lot on the right. (There are No restrooms). Leader: John Behrmann (232-1603)
- JAN 22 (Sunday) GARFIELD PARK - Assemble in the parking lot beside the swimming pool at 1:30 PM for an easy hike of 4 miles. Leaders: Win & Mary Pulsifer (784-1835).
- JAN 28 (Saturday) SAHM PARK - Meet in the parking lot north of the Sears Store at Castleton Square Shopping Center for a 7 mile hike starting at 9:30 AM. PLEASE NOTE - This is a new meeting place. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562).
- JAN 29 (Sunday) WOOLLENS GARDENS:- From East 56th Street go northeast on Fall Creek Parkway. Turn right onto the old road that follows the creek and dead ends just before the I-465 bridge. Park alongside this dead end road. Slow and moderate hike of 2 to 3 miles will start at 2:00 PM. Leaders: Alberta Neill (634-7672) & Juanita Lauth (353-6325)
- FEB 4 & 5 (Saturday and Sunday) WINTER OVERNIGHT AT SPRING MILL STATE PARK
