- FEB 9 (Saturday) EAST INDY - Meet at 10:00 AM in the parking lot of the Trinity Lutheran Church, 8500 East 16th Street, for easy 5 and 10 mile hikes. The 5 mile hikes will vary each week. Leader: Al Drehobl (898-3632).
- FEB 10 (Sunday) IUPUI - Go west on Michigan Street (one-way) from downtown past the School of Dentistry to Lansing Street. Turn left and go to New York Street (one-way east). Turn left again and enter the parking lot at the first entrance on the left. Easy 5 to 6 mile hike starts at 2:00 PM. Leader: Joe Lehman (297-1632).
- FEB 13 (Wednesday) STATE CAPITOL - Meet at the rotunda on the 2nd floor for a 3 mile hike at noon. Be prepared to go up or down every staircase in the building. Leader: John V. Behrmann (462-7058).
- FEB 16 (Saturday) EAST INDY - See directions for February 9th.
- FEB 16 and 17 (Saturday & Sunday) HUESTON WOODS STATE PARK OVERNIGHT - (For members and their invited guests only). The reservations for this event have been filled. Those of you who have made reservations, please plan to arrive about noon. Our first hike will be about 2:00 P.M. There will be a 50¢ registration fee upon arrival, and you will be given a copy of schedule of events. Any questions about this, please contact Bill Larrison at (359-7538).
- FEB 17 (Sunday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Meet at 2:00 PM in the parking lot for the Life Course for a 6 mile hike. There will be an entrance fee. Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717).
- FEB 19 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Meet at 10:00 AM in the Nature Center parking lot. Look for Hiking Club signs. This 5 mile easy hike will be repeated every Tuesday through March 19, 1985. Entrance fee. Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717).
- FEB 23 (Saturday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Meet at noon in the Nature Center parking lot. Look for Hiking Club signs. Self-guided hikes of 3, 6, or 10 miles. This hike will be repeated every Saturday through March 16. Entrance fee. Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717).
- FEB 24 (Sunday) MERIDIAN-KESSLER - Easy sidewalk hike of 5 or 10 miles starting at 1:00 PM. Go to 3908 N. Pennsylvania and drive in alley to back parking lot. Leader: Carol Sutcliff (926-7251).
- FEB 26 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See directions for February 19th.
- MAR 2 (Saturday) A. ACROSS THE STATE - PART III - Assemble at West Washington and Tibbs Ave. at 7:00 AM for car shuttle to Stilesville. Trail lunch and liquid for this 24 mile road hike. Leader: Tom Patterson (849-9528).

B. EAGLE CREEK PARK - See directions for February 23rd.

- MAR 3 (Sunday) A. ACROSS THE STATE - PART IV - Allow 3/4 hour travel time. Take US 40 or I-70 east to Greenfield. Go about 1 mile east of the Hancock County Courthouse to Apple street. Turn north about 1 block and assemble in the Riley Park Parking Area at 7:00 AM for car shuttle. Trail lunch and liquid for this 27 mile road hike. Leader: Tom Patterson (849-9528).
- B. ARBUCKLE ACRES - Take I-74 west to the Brownsburg exit. Turn right (south) and go about 1 mile to Arbuckle Acres Park on the right just before the railroad tracks. Go to the end of the lane and park in the graveled area. Easy hike of 4 to 5 miles to start at 2:00 PM. Leader: Hank Moore (852-4717).
- MAR 5 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See directions for February 19th.
- MAR 9 (Saturday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See directions for February 23rd.
- MAR 9 (Saturday) GEIST RESERVOIR - Go northeast on Fall Creek Road 1/4 mile past the Sailing Club. Park on the north end of the causeway along the side of the road. Meet at 10:00 AM for a wooded 12 mile hike. Leader: Bob Begeman (359-4174).
- MAR 10 (Sunday) BROAD RIPPLE AND CANAL - Meet in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple on Westfield Blvd. just east of College Ave. at 2:00 PM for an easy 6 to 7 mile hike. Leader: Bill Larrison (359-7538).
- MAR 12 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See directions for February 19th.
- MAR 14 (Thursday) GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND CLUB SOCIAL - (For members and their invited guests only). Meet at 7:30 PM in Fellowship Hall of the Covenant Presbyterian Church at 2305 N. Kitley. (Park in the rear and enter from the parking lot). DIRECTIONS: Kitley is 6500 east, between Arlington and Shadeland on 21st Street. Go north on Kitley from 21st to the second church on the right. There will be a business meeting followed by the program for the evening. Harrison Feldman will present "A PRINCESS CRUISE" - taking us through the Panama Canal, and visiting many exotic ports.

- MAR 21 (Thursday) RIVERVIEW, HOLIDAY PARK & CANAL - Join us on the first day of spring for a moderate 5 mile hike, hopefully seeing some of the first wildflowers of spring. Meet at 10:00 AM in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple on Westfield Blvd. just east of College Ave. Leaders: Alice Brink (255-0166) & Alberta Neill (634-7672).
- MAR 23 (Saturday) TEN O'CLOCK LINE - Meet at the Nature Center in Brown County State Park for 6, 12 and 16 mile rugged hikes at a moderate pace. Trail lunch and liquid for longer hikes. Entrance fee. Six mile hikers must call leader prior to hike for placement of cars. Meet promptly at 9:00 AM for car shuttle. Leader: Al Drehobl (898-3632).
- MAR 24 (Sunday) CHERRY TREE SHOPPING CENTER - Assemble at 7:30 AM for a 9 mile road hike. Meet in shopping center parking lot about 11000 east on Washington St., Leader: Ursula Breeding (359-8686).

- MAR 30 (Saturday) MISSISSINewa TRAIL - Allow 2 hours travel time. Take US 31 north. About 5 miles south of Peru watch for SR 218, but DO NOT TURN ON IT. Proceed 1 mile north to the next intersection. Turn right (east) and go about 7½ miles. Turn left (north) and go 1-3/4 miles. Turn right. After crossing the dam turn right into the parking lot. If confused, watch for signs directing you to the dam. Hike will start at 11:00 AM. Trail lunch and liquid. Patch is available for this 10 to 12 mile moderate to

rugged hike. Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562).

- MAR 30 (Saturday) B. INDIANAPOLIS SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA TOUR - Meet in the lobby of the former Circle Theater at 1:45 PM. Tour will begin at 2:00 PM. 2 mile downtown hike to follow tour. Hike will be slow and easy. Leaders: Alberta Neill (634-7672) and Florence Krasienko (898-6003).
- MAR 31 (Sunday) SOUTHEASTWAY PARK - Meet at 8:00 AM for an 8 mile hike. Assemble in the parking lot at Southeastway Park, 5624 south on East County Line Road. Leader: Ursula Breeding (359-8686).

- APR 5 (Friday) MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST - Allow 1½ hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the sign for Morgan-Monroe State Forest. Go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. Turn left and go to the fire tower parking lot for moderate to rugged hikes of 8, 16 and 20 miles. Trail lunch and liquid. Hikes will start at 9:00 AM. Leader: Al Dreho1 (898-3632).
- APR 6 (Saturday) A. BEARS OF THE BLUE RIVER - Take I-74 east approximately 25 miles to SR 9. Turn left (north) and drive one block to Morristown Road. Turn right and go 1/2 mile to WSVL radio station on the right. Allow one hour driving time. Hike will start promptly at 9:00 AM due to car shuttle. Trail lunch and liquid. Patch is available for this 14 mile moderate hike. Leader: John V. Behrmann (462-7058). FHS
- B. SHADES STATE PARK - Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time. Take I-74 west 3. to Jamestown exit. Go through Jamestown and follow SR 234 west to the Park. Entrance fee. The 8 mile hike will start at noon. Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439).
