SELF-GUIDED HIKES - The Board of Directors has learned that there is a possibility that some members may be taking advantage of self-guided hikes to list more mileage than they actually hike. These hikes are based on the honor system, and it is important that each person report to the hike leader any difference in mileage than what is signed up for. REMEMBER: You should sign the roster and liability release before hiking. Leaders of self-guided hikes have the same responsibility as leaders on other hikes to sign the roster and to attest to the mileage to be given to each hiker. BE SURE TO FOLLOW THE ROUTE AS LAID OUT BY THE LEADER. Do not sign up and then hike some other route.

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PRICE INCREASE IN NAME TAGS - The price of name tags from our supplier has gone from \$2.65 to \$2.90. If using old membership application forms to sign up new members, please change the price.

- AUG 7 (Wednesday) RIVERVIEW HIKE - Sign in at the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple on Westfield just east of College Avenue between 5:30 and 6:00 PM for easy self-guided hikes of 5 or 8 miles. Leader: Carol Sutcliffe (926-7251).
- AUG 8 (Thursday) VILLAGE FARMS - Take US 31 north to 161st Street. Turn left and go 500 feet to Farr Hill Drive. Turn left and park on the street. Meet at 2:00 PM for an easy hike of 5 miles. Leader: George MacLean (896-5769).
- AUG 10 (Saturday) SOUTHEASTWAY PARK ROAD HIKE - Meet at 6:30 AM for a 9 mile hike. Assemble in the parking lot at Southeastway Park, 5624 south on East County Line Road. Leader: Ursula Breeding (359-8686).
- AUG 11 (Sunday) SHADES STATE PARK - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take I-74 west to the Jamestown exit. Go through Jamestown and follow SR 234 west to the park entrance. Admission fee. Assemble in the parking area near the old campground and the picnic area at 2:30 PM for about 5 miles of moderate to rugged hiking. Leader: Odie Cassetty (244-9913).
- AUG 14 (Wednesday) RIVERVIEW HIKE - See instructions for August 7th.
- AUG 15 (Thursday) INDIANA STATE MUSEUM HIKE - Tour of Museum (202 N. Alabama) at 1:00 PM after which there will be a slow & easy 2 mile downtown hike. Parking available free for one hour in Museum's lot. Leader: Alberta Neill (634-7672).
- AUG 17 (Saturday) DEAM WILDERNESS - Assemble at 9:30 AM for a moderate to rugged 15 mile hike. Allow 2-1/4 hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to SR 46. Go east through Bloomington and turn right on SR 446. Cross the Monroe Reservoir causeway and go 4.3 miles further. Turn left at the road just past the Maumee Boy Scout sign. Go about 6 miles to the fire tower parking lot. Bring trail lunch and liquid. Leader: Al Drehobl (898-3632).
- AUG 18 (Sunday) SHAKAMAK STATE PARK - Allow 2-1/2 hours travel time. Take I-70 west to SR 59 south and SR 48 west to the park entrance. Entrance fee. Follow signs to beach parking area near shelter house. A 5 mile hike will start at 9:00 AM and a 6 mile hike will start at 1:00 PM. Bring trail lunch and liquid, to be eaten between the

hikes, near the cars. Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439).

- AUG 20 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK HIKE - Meet at the nature center in the park at 10:00 AM for an easy 5 to 6 mile hike. Go through the gate at 56th street and follow the road back near the reservoir to almost 71st street. Turn left and park in allotted parking area. Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439).
- AUG 21 (Wednesday) RIVERVIEW HIKE - See instructions for August 7th.
- AUG 24 (Saturday) RUSTER PARK TO SOUTHEASTWAY PARK - Go one mile east on Washington Street from Washington Square to German Church Road. Go 1-1/2 miles south on German Church to Prospect, then 1/3 mile east to Ruster Park. Park in the parking lot for a 15 mile road hike to start at 6:30 AM Leader: Ursula Breeding (359-8686)
- AUG 25 (Sunday) LIEBER STATE PARK - ALLOW 1-1/2 hours driving time. Take I-70 west to the exit for SR 243. Go south on 243 to the park. Entrance fee. Assemble in the picnic parking lot, which is the left fork near the end of the road, at 1:30 PM for 5 to 6 miles - easy to moderate. Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439).
- AUG 27 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK HIKE - See instructions for August 20th.
- AUG 28 (Wednesday) RIVERVIEW HIKE - See instructions for August 7th.
- AUG 31, Sept 1 & 2, (Saturday through Monday) LABOR DAY WEEKEND AT NATURAL BRIDGE PARK - (For members and their invited guests only). The club members received the reservation supplement in the previous schedule mail. For further information about this event please contact Bill Larrison (359-7538).
- SEP 4 (Wednesday) ELLENBERGER PARK - Meet at Ellenberger Park, 5400 block of East St. Clair, between 5:15 and 5:30 PM for a 4, 6, or 8 mile self-guided hike. Leader: Ursula Breeding (359-8686).
- SEP 7 (Saturday) JACKSON-WASHINGTON STATE FOREST - Allow 2 hours travel time from south side of the city. Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit, US 50 West. Go west on US 50 to Brownstown. Take SR 250 left about 3 miles to the Jackson State Forest entrance on the left. Assemble in the parking lot beyond the lake at 9:00 AM for moderate to rugged hikes of 7 and 15 miles. (NOTE: 7 mile hikers must call leader in advance). Leader: Al Drehobl 898-3632).
- SEP 8 (Sunday) KOKOMO HISTORICAL HIKE - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel. Go north on US 31. Take the By-Pass in Kokomo, not the business route. Turn right at the McDonald's in Markland Mall on to SR 22 and 35. DO NOT TURN at the McDonald's on the south side of town. Go about 3 miles and watch for the Wildcat Creek Reservoir sign at County Road 500 E. Turn left (north) and go one mile to Wildcat Creek Reservoir. Park on the left side of the road just before the Reservoir. Moderate hikes of 7 and 13 miles. A SHUTTLE WILL LEAVE PROMPTLY AT 8:00 AM. Trail lunch and liquid for the longer hike. Leader: Robin Ott (1-453-0579).
- SEP 11 (Wednesday) ELLENBERGER PARK HIKE - See instructions for September 4th.
- SEP 12 (Thursday) GENERAL ASSEMBLY - ELECTION OF OFFICERS - (For members and their invited guests only). Meet at 7:30 PM in Fellowship Hall of the Covenant Presbyterian church at 2305 N. Kitley. (Park in the rear and enter from the parking lot.). DIRECTIONS: Kitley is 6500 east, between Arlington and Shadeland on 21st street. Go north on Kitley from 21st to the second church on the right. The nominating committee has presented the following slate of candidates for office:

DIRECTORS: Sam Lloyd, Jim Ernsting, Win Pulsifer, and Fred Eckstein. The voting for the five line offices will be done separately, and the defeated candidates will automatically be considered as nominees for the office of Director before the balloting for the Directors commences. Further nominations from the floor may be made by the members if properly moved and seconded. All persons nominated from the floor must be present at the meeting.

Following the elections, George Lindley, who has bicycled in many foreign countries, will narrate a slide program showing places he has visited and telling us about his experiences.

- SEP 14 (Saturday) SPURGEON HOLLOW, BACK COUNTRY HIKE - Allow 2-1/2 hours driving time. Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit. Go west on US 50 through Brownstown. Take SR 135 south about 9.1 miles and turn left just after the Muscatatuck River bridge. Follow Delaney Lake Park signs. Continue past Delaney Park and turn left at the sign for Spurgeon Hollow. Park near the lake. Hike to start at 8:45 AM. Leader: Marjorie Begeman (359-4174). 9 miles, moderate to rugged.
- SEP 15 (Sunday) (A) WILLIAMS DAM & COVERED BRIDGE - Allow 2-1/2 hours driving time from I-465 and SR 37 south. Take SR 37 south to stop light for Bedford exit. Turn right onto 450 West. Follow for about 9 miles to Williams Dam. Park in the public fishing area next to the Dam. Meet at 8:30 AM for a rugged 21 mile country road hike. Bring a trail lunch and liquid. Leader: Al Drehabl (898-3632).  
(B) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Meet at 2:00 PM in the parking lot just inside the gate at 56th street for a 5 to 6 mile hike. Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717).
- SEP 18 (Wednesday) ELLENBERGER PARK - See instructions for September 4th.
- SEP 21 (Saturday) WILBUR WRIGHT MEMORIAL - Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time from the east side of Indianapolis for this 8 or 13 mile hike beginning at 9:00 AM. Take I-70 east to the Wilbur Wright Road/New Lisbon exit (#131). This exit is about 14 miles east of the New Castle exit. Go north to New Lisbon (about .6 mile) and turn right where the sign reads Wilbur Wright Memorial. Cross the tracks and turn left on Wilbur Wright road, and follow the Wilbur Wright signs carefully. You will be in Millville in about 15 minutes. Go on about 1.5 miles more and turn right on county road 100N. Go .5 mile and turn left on county road 750E. The memorial is on left side of road, and there is limited parking, so try to car pool. An alternate route would be to exit at New Castle, go north to SR #38, go east on #38 and look for Wilbur Wright signs which will direct you north on Wilbur Wright Road. Bring lunch and water. Leader: Betty Woodward (545-4480).
- SEP 22 (Sunday) FOUR LAKES - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign, and go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. IF YOU ARE GOING ON THE LONGER HIKE (14 to 16 miles), turn right and go to the parking lot for Bryant Creek. IF YOU ARE GOING ON THE SHORTER HIKE (8 miles), please drop your passengers at Bryant Creek, and then continue about 2.6 miles on the main forest road to the road for Beanblossom Lake. Turn right and go about a mile to the Beanblossom Lake parking area to the right. BE THERE BY 9:40 AM. to be shuttled back to the Bryant Creek area where the hikes will start at 10:00 AM. The short hike will end at Beanblossom Lake. Short hikers bring liquid, but can leave their lunches in their cars. Long hikers carry liquid and lunch to be eaten at Beanblossom after the short hike. NOTE: This has become a traditional birthday hike in honor of ED CHAMBERS who will be 85 on Wednesday the 25th. Leaders: Ed Chambers and Peggy Franzen (546-3185).
- SEP 25 (Wednesday) ELLENBERGER PARK - See instructions for September 4th.

- SEP 28 (Saturday) IRVINGTON HIKE - Meet in the parking lot by the pool in Ellenberger Park, 5301 East St. Clair, at 9:00 AM for a 5 or 11 mile hike through Irvington and the old east side of Indianapolis. Bring lunch and water for the longer hike. Leader: Betty Woodward (545-4480).
- SEP 29 (Sunday) CROOKED CREEK HIKE - Allow 2 hours travel time. From Nashville go west on SR 46 for 2.7 miles past the west entrance to Brown County State Park. Look for a group of buildings on the north side of highway; 2 trailers, a log house, a small house and a white building formerly a church. Just past these buildings is a green road sign saying "Bloomington" and "Nashville". Turn south on a gravel road just opposite this area and go 2.7 miles to the Crooked Creek Lake parking area on the left. Meet at 9:00 AM for a moderate hike of approximately 13 miles. Bring lunch and water. This hike is unscouted and goes north of the lake. Leaders: Bob and Marjorie Begeman (359-4174).
- OCT 1 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Meet at 10:00 AM at the parking lot at the entrance off 56th street for an easy 5 to 6 mile hike. This hike will be repeated alternately by Libby Moore and Mary Kidwell throughout month of October. Leaders: Libby Moore (852-4717). and Mary Kidwell (852-2439).
- OCT 5 and 6 (Saturday and Sunday) BACKPACK IN HOOSIER NATIONAL FOREST - Be sure to contact Libby Moore (852-4717) for reservations and information about this backpack. Take SR 37 south to Bloomington. Then follow SR 46 east to the intersection with SR 446. Turn right and go about 12 miles. About 1/2 mile past the Hardin Ridge sign you will come to the Tower Road on the left. Turn left and go about a mile to the Horsemen Camp. Meet there at 11:00 AM on Saturday. PLEASE NOTE: DO NOT ADVERTISE THIS EVENT IN THE PAPERS.
- OCT 6 (Sunday) CATARACT FALLS - Take I-70 west to the Cloverdale exit. Take US 231 south for about 7 miles to the sign for the Cataract Falls State Recreation Area. Turn right and go about 3 miles to the entrance. Admission fee. Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time. Meet at 9:00 AM for an easy to moderate hike of 6 and 12 miles. There will be a festival in the town of Cataract so you may want to plan on staying around and enjoying the event. Leader: Jim Stern (844-3791).
