DEC 6 (Saturday) CHRISTMAS PARTY (For members and their invited guests only). This is a reminder. See previous schedule for all the details. There will be a pitch-in dinner at 6:30 PM followed by our entertainment for the evening which will feature a return engagement by the "SWEET ADELINES" singing group.

DEC 10 (Wednesday) A.M. INDIANA - TRACK 13 - UNION STATION - There will be a block of 20 seats available for us at this program, which is on from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM. The first 20 to call the leaders will be able to see the show. To attend the show, be there at 8:30 AM, go to the door at Meridian and Louisiana (across from parking garage). Go up the escalator and to the right - there will be guards there to show you where. Those who do not come for the program should meet us right after 10:00 AM in the lobby between the Information Desk on the main floor and the Illinois - Louisiana door. We will have a 2 mile slow & easy hike downtown. Leaders: Alberta Neill (634-7672) and Juanita Lauth (353-6325) (F, PS, under 2.5)

DEC 13 (Saturday) METAMORA CHRISTMAS HIKE - Allow 1-1/2 hours for travel. Take US 52 south-east to Metamora. Turn right and go into town. Meet in the Whitewater Canal State Memorial parking lot on Clayborne Street (up the hill). There will be an easy 4 mile hike starting at 3:30 PM. This historical old town will be decorated for the Christmas season, and as it gets dusk, the luminaries will be lighted all over town. Leaders: Mary & Win Pulsifer (784-1835). (F, HS, 2.5)

DEC 14 (Sunday) WALNUT CREEK NATURE CONSERVANCY HIKE - Allow 1 hour for travel. Meet at 1:00 PM for a 5 to 6 mile easy hike. Take US 36 west to Groveland. Turn north on second road past Groveland. There is a picture of a Hereford Cow at the junction of this "T" road and US 36. (If you arrive in Bainbridge, you have gone too far west. Turn around and retrace to first road on the north). Proceed north 1 mile to crossroad, turn east and go about 1/8 mile. Turn north again and go 1 mile to dead end. Turn west and follow winding road to Pine Bluff Bridge. DEC 20 (Saturday) WANAMAKER WALK - Assemble at 8:00 AM at grade school, corner of Arlington and Edgewood (6000 South) for easy road hikes of 5 miles or 12 to 13 miles. Longer hikers will eat lunch at an "Ordinary" about halfway into the hike. Leader: Jackie McKelfresh (356-3734 or 232-9427) (F, PS, 2.5 to 3.5)

DEC 21 (Sunday) GREENFIELD PARKS - An easy hike of 7 to 8 miles visiting the 5 parks in Greenfield. Hike to start at 1:30 PM at Riley Park swimming pool parking lot. Take I-70 east to SR 9 (Greenfield/Maxwell exit). Turn right and drive 3 blocks to 200 N. Turn left and go 7 blocks to 250 E. Turn right and drive 1.7 miles to the parking lot on the right. Leader: John V. Behrmann (462-7058). (F, PS, 3.5)

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4 DEC 27 (Saturday) SWEETWATER - CORDRY LAKES - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 135 south to SR 252. Go east on 252 to signs for Nineveh - Prince's Lakes. Turn right and go south through Nineveh for about 7.5 miles. DO NOT follow Prince's Lake signs but DO FOLLOW Church of the Lakes signs. Go slow because of the narrow roads. Do not park at the church. Park near the saleshouse. Parking may be limited, so car-pool if possible. Self-guided hikes of 5, 10, or 15 miles begin at 10:00 AM. Bring lunch and water. Leader: Joe Wilhelm. (241-3695) (M, PS)
- 4 DEC 28 (Sunday) INDIANAPOLIS MOTOR SPEEDWAY - Take west 16th street to the Speedway Museum entrance (4790 W. 16th) and park in the Museum parking lot for a 4 to 5 mile easy hike around the grounds and track. Hike to start at 2:00 PM. Those who wish to visit the Museum (admission fee) should do so before the hike as there will not be time enough afterwards. Leader: Nell Larrison (359-7538) (F, PS, 2.5)
- 4 JAN 1 (Thursday) ELLENBERGER PARK NEW YEAR'S DAY HIKE - Meet at 8:00 AM in the parking lot near the swimming pool at Ellenberger Park, 5400 east St. Clair St. and 800 N. Ritter. Easy 6 mile hike. Leaders: Marge & Bob Begeman (359-4174) (F, PS, 3 to 3.5)

- JAN 23 (Friday) SOCIAL - WELIEVERS SMORGASBORD - HAGERSTOWN - Weliever's Smorgasbord in Hagerstown is well known for its variety & quality of food. The special for Friday is shrimp. Cost is \$10.95 per person (Senior citizen discount available). This includes all non-alcoholic drinks. One hour drive time. Take I-70 east to SR 1. Go north on SR 1 to SR 38 & turn east 1/2 mile to Hagerstown. The restaurant is in the middle of town on the north side of the street. Meet in Hagerstown at 7:00 PM. Reservations are not taken at the restaurant, but members should call the Begemans (359-4174) for a headcount. There will probably be a wait to be seated.

SELF-GUIDED HIKES: This is to restate some of the rules for Self-guided hikes as approved by the board of directors in June 1985 and published in the bulletin containing the schedule for August & September 1985. Hikers must sign the hike roster BEFORE hiking. Leaders of self-guided hikes have the same responsibility as leaders on other hikes to sign the roster and to attest to the mileage. No credit is to be given for mileage hiked before signing the roster. These hikes are based on the honor system and it is up to each hiker to report to the leader any difference in mileage than what was signed up for. **BE SURE TO FOLLOW THE ROUTE AS LAID OUT BY THE LEADER.**

SNOW AND ICE This is old man winter in Indiana. If the weather becomes hazardous and you are in doubt as to the wisdom of taking the scheduled hike, please check with the leader. Also in extremely bad weather please listen to radio and TV broadcasts for cancellation of hikes and requests by government officials for people to stay off the highways. Our schedules are made out several months in advance and the pathfinder can't guarantee the weatherman's co-operation
