- APR 4 (Saturday) KNOB LAKE HIKE - JACKSON FOREST - Allow about 2 hours driving time from the south side of Indianapolis. Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit (US 50 WEST). Go west on US 50 to Brownstown. Go left on SR 250 about 3 miles to the Jackson State Forest entrance on the LEFT. Assemble in the parking lot beyond the lake at 10:00 AM for moderate to rugged hikes of 5 to 6 miles and 13 to 15 miles. This beautiful area is hilly, most of the steeper hills will be on the longer hike. Trail lunch and water for long hike. Leader: Bill Larrison (359-7538) (H, NS, 2.5-3)
- APR 5 (Sunday) (A) CANAL - BROADRIPPLE TO DOWNTOWN - There will be hikes of 9 or 18 miles. Assemble in the parking lot over the canal in Broad Ripple just east of College Ave. at 7:30 AM. Bring trail lunch and water for picnic in University Park. Hikers going one way only are responsible for arranging their own transportation back to their cars. Leader: Tom Patterson (849-9528) (F, PS, 3).
(B) LOCKERBIE SQUARE HIKE AND TOUR OF JAMES WHITCOMB RILEY HOME - Meet at 11:45 AM in front of the Riley Home which is on Lockerbie between East Street and Park Avenue. (Lockerbie is just north of New York Street). Please park on the street rather than in the parking lot. We will tour the home first and then have a SLOW & EASY hike of 2 miles. Entrance fee is \$1.00. Leaders: Alberta Neill (634-7672) and Juanita Lauth (353-6325). (F, PS, under 2.5).
- APR 7 (Tuesday) (A) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Assemble in the parking lot just inside the 56th Street entrance for an easy hike of 5 miles starting at 10:00 AM. This hike will be repeated the two next Tuesdays. Leaders: Win & Mary Pulsifer (784-1835). (M, NS, 2.5)
(B) CHRISTIAN PARK - Each Tuesday evening in April there will be a self-guided hike of 4 or 8 miles starting at 5:30 PM. Meet at the Community Center at Christian Park, 4200 east English Ave. Leaders: Bob & Marge Begeman (359-4174) (F, PS)
- APR 11 (Saturday) CROSLEY STATE FISH & WILDLIFE AREA - Take I-65 south to SR 46 EAST (Columbus exit) to SR 7 southeast through North Vernon. The fish & wildlife area is 5 miles south of North Vernon on SR 3. Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time from I-465. Meet in the parking lot at 9:00 AM for hikes of approximately 9, 12, or 17 miles over gravel roads, trails, and some cross-country. There may be some wet and muddy areas. Bring trail lunch and water. (M, NS, 3). Leader: Al Dreho1 (898-3632).
- APR 12 (Sunday) (A) GLENDALE TO CIRCLE - Assemble at Glendale Shopping Center on east side of Rural Street at 7:30 AM for hikes of 9, or 18 to 19 miles. Trail lunch & water for picnic in University Park. Hikers going one way are responsible for arranging their transportation. (F, PS, 3) Leader: Tom Patterson (849-9528).
(B) MOORESVILLE HIKE - Take SR 67 south to Mooresville. Turn right at Gray's Cafeteria, go about 1/2 block and turn left into shopping center parking lot. Meet at 2:00 P.M. for easy 5 to 6 mile hike. (F, PS, 2.5) Leader: Pat Eckstein (996-2597)

- APR 14 (Tuesday) (A) EAGLE CREEK PARK - see instructions for April 7.
(B) CHRISTIAN PARK - see instructions for April 7.
- APR 17 (Good Friday) MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the sign for Morgan-Monroe Forest and go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. Turn left, drive 5 miles to the fire tower. Meet at 9:00 AM for hikes of 9, 16, or 20 miles. Longer hikes will be moderate to rugged in spots. Bring trail lunch and water. (H, NS, 3) Leader: Al Drehabl (898-3632).
- APR 18 (Saturday) WHITEWATER GORGE PARK - Meet at 9:00 A.M. for a moderate hike of 8 to 9 miles. Take I-70 east to Exit 151A (US 27 south) at Richmond. Turn right onto Waterfall Road. Proceed for about a mile and turn right into Whitewater Gorge-Springwood. Park in the first parking area on the left. Allow 1-1/2 to 2 hours travel time. (F, NS, 3). Leaders: Frank and Wilma Thompson (241-7154).
- APR 19 (Sunday) GARFIELD PARK EASTER HIKE - Assemble in the parking lot beside the swimming pool at 2:00 PM for an easy 4 mile hike including a tour through the conservatory with all the Easter flowers. (F, NS, 2.5). Leaders: Win & Mary Pulsifer (784-1835)
- APR 21 (Tuesday) (A) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See instructions for April 7.
(B) CHRISTIAN PARK - See instructions for April 7.
- APR 25 (Saturday) 30TH ANNIVERSARY BANQUET - (For members and their invited guests only) Reservations are required. Please send in your reservation as soon as possible, as the deadline for this event is APRIL 11, 1987. - APR 26 (Sunday) MCCORMICK'S CREEK STATE PARK - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 67 south to Spencer and turn east on SR 46 and go a few miles to the park entrance. (FEE). Assemble in parking area near nature center at 1:00 P.M. for a moderate 8 to 10 mile hike. (M, NS, 2.5). Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439).
- APR 28 (Tuesday) (A) BROAD RIPPLE AND MAROTT PARKS - Meet in the main parking lot of Broad Ripple Park, 1450 Broad Ripple Avenue (East 62nd street) for a 7 mile hike starting at 9:30 AM. (F, P & NS, 3). Leader: Dorothy Field (253-7114).
(B) CHRISTIAN PARK - See instructions for April 7.
- MAY 2 & 3 (Saturday & Sunday) HEMLOCK CLIFFS BACKPACK - (And Dayhike) - Allow 3 hours travel time. Meet at 10:00 AM for an easy backpack - 3 miles in and 3 miles out. A beautiful area with spring water and caverns, and hopefully spring wildflowers. Go south on SR 37 through Grantsburg to the Blue River (not marked). The bridge is a low concrete one, 1/2 mile south of Grantsburg. Turn right (west) on Union Chapel Road (may not be marked), the first road one mile south of the Blue River, just before the end of the new SR 37 Road. (If you get to I-64, turn around and go back north). Go 2.6 miles on Union Chapel to a fork. Keep right on gravel road for 3.4 miles to second "Y". Hemlock Cliffs sign should be posted there. Keep right on small paved road to parking lot (old picnic area). PLEASE CALL BOB BEGEMAN FOR RESERVATIONS FOR THE BACKPACK. DAYHIKERS - welcome on Saturday with a minimum of 6 miles with longer options. (M, NS, 3). Leaders: Bob & Marge Begeman (359-4174).
- MAY 3 (Sunday) MOUNDS STATE PARK - Take I-69 north to the second Anderson exit. Go north on SR 109 to SR 232. Turn right and continue to the Park (Fee). Meet at the pavilion parking lot shortly past the Park office at 2:00 PM for a SLOW and EASY 4 to 5 mile hike, including a visit to the Mounds and to the Nature Center. (F, NS, 2.5). Leaders: Juanita Lauth (353-6325) and Alberta Neill (634-7672).

- MAY 5 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Meet at 10:00 AM at the parking lot at the entrance off 56th Street for an easy 6 to 8 mile hike. (M, NS, 2.5) Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439).
- MAY 7 (Thursday) BROAD RIPPLE - CANAL - Meet at 5:30 PM in the parking lot over the canal just east of College Ave. There will be self-guided hikes of 4 or 8 miles (F, H) Leader: Tom Patterson (849-9528). Hike to be repeated May 21st and May 28th.
- MAY 9 (Saturday) BEAUTIFUL BROWN COUNTY - Meet at 10:00 AM in the parking area for the nature center in Brown County State Park for a 10 mile hike. Allow 2 hours travel time. Take SR 135 south to the park entrance, then follow signs to Nature Center. H, NS, 2.5). Leaders: Peg & Heydon Franzen (812-988-2461). Trail lunch and water.
- MAY 10 (Sunday) TURKEY RUN STATE PARK - Allow 2 hours driving time. Take I-74 west to the Jamestown exit. Go through Jamestown and take SR 234 west to SR 47. Turn left and go about 14 miles to the Park entrance. (Fee). Park in the Inn parking lot for a moderate 6 to 7 mile hike to begin at 1:00 PM. (H, NS, 2.5-3). Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439)
- MAY 12 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See instructions for May 5.
- MAY 14 (Thursday) GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND CLUB SOCIAL - (For members and invited guests only). Meet at 7:30 PM in Fellowship Hall of Covenant Presbyterian Church at 2305 N. Kitley. (Park in rear and enter from parking lot). DIRECTIONS: Kitley is 6500 east between Arlington and Shadeland. Go north on Kitley from 21st Street to second church on the right. Short business meeting will be followed by the evening program. Charlene Steckbeck of the Crisis & Suicide Intervention Service (State Dept of Health) will give an interesting and informative discussion of problems encountered.
- MAY 16 (Saturday) SWEETWATER - CORDRY LAKES - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 135 south to SR 252, and go east to signs for Nineveh-Prince's Lakes. Turn right and go south through Nineveh for about 7.5 miles. DO NOT follow Prince's Lake signs but DO FOLLOW Church of the Lakes signs. Go slow because of narrow roads. DO NOT park at the Church. Park near the saleshouse - parking may be limited so car-pool if possible. Self-guided hikes of 5, 10, or 15 miles begin at 10:00 AM. Bring lunch and water. M, PS). Leader: Joe Wilhelm (241-3695).
- MAY 17 (Sunday) OLD NORTHSIDE/SOUTHSIDE HIKE - Assemble in the rear of All Saints Episcopal Church at 16th and Central Avenue for a 6 to 7 mile hike. There will be a 5 minute tour of a 100 year old German Church. The hike will start at 1:00 P.M. (F, PS, 2.5-3) Leader: Jim Stern (844-3791).
- MAY 19 (Tuesday) HOLLIDAY AND MAROTT PARKS - Meet in the canal parking lot, near College and Westfield Blvd., for a 7 mile hike starting at 9:30 A.M. (F & M, P & NS, 3). Leader: Dorothy Field (253-7114).

- MAY 25 (Monday) FALL CREEK AND THEREABOUTS - Meet in parking lot below bank/office building at Windridge Shopping Center, 5500 N. Emerson Ave. for hike of 6 to 8 miles, starting at 9:00 AM. (F,P&NS,3) Leader: Dorothy Field (253-7114)
- MAY 27 (Wednesday) KEMPER HOUSE - Also known as the "Wedding Cake House", 1028 North Delaware Street. Park in the parking area south of the house, near the Delaware side. Meet at 1:30 PM for tour of the house (no charge, but donation accepted), and a 2 mile Slow & Easy hike following the tour. Leader: Alberta Neill (634-7672) (F,PS, 2,5, or less)

- MAY 31 (Sunday) SHADES STATE PARK - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take I-74 west to the Jamestown exit. Go through Jamestown and follow SR 234 west to the Park (Fee). There will be a 6 to 8 mile hike at 1:00 PM. (H,NS,2.5-3). Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439)
- JUN 2 (Tuesday) WHITE RIVER PARKWAY - Each Tuesday in June, there will be a 4 and 8 mile self-guided hike, to begin at 5:30 PM. Park in the lot on White River Parkway, West Drive, just north of 30th Street. (White River Parkway runs along the west side of White River). (F,PS) Leaders: Bob & Marge Begeman (359-4174).
- JUN 6 (Saturday) WABASH HERITAGE TRAIL - Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time. Take I-65 north to SR 43, and exit at West Lafayette. Turn left towards West Lafayette and go a short distance (about 500 feet) and turn left on Burnett Road. Go to the end of the road (.4 mile) and turn left on N. 9th Street. Drive 1.6 miles to Tippecanoe Battlefield parking lot on the left. Meet at 10:00 AM for a 13 mile hike over completed portions of the Wabash Heritage Trail. Bring trail lunch and water.
