- AUG 1 (Saturday) NOBSTONE TRAIL MAINTENANCE WORK - The 1987 Knobstone project will be near the Elk Creek trailhead. Allow 2 hours driving time. Take I-65 south to Salem exit at Scottsburg. Go west on SR 56 for 8.3 miles. Turn left at sign for Elk Creek Lake. Go south 2.2 miles, follow signs for the State Fishing Area. Meet at 10:00 AM with trail lunch and water. Additional information please contact the Conservation Officer, Bob Begeman (359-4174).
- AUG 2 (Sunday) A. DOWNTOWN AND BEYOND - Meet on the Circle at 8:00 AM for hikes of 5, 10, or 16 miles. Self-guided hikes will be on roads. Contact leader, Charlie Brunette (542-1355) if you plan to take the shorter options. (F,PS).
B. BROWN COUNTY STATE PARK - Meet at parking lot for Ogle Lake at 1:30 PM for a 4 to 5 mile slow & easy hike, part of which will be around Ogle Lake and part on other trails. (F,NS,under 2.5) Leader: Alberta Neill (634-7672).
- AUG 4 (Tuesday) A. EAGLE CREEK - WEST - Take west 56th Street to Eagle Creek Park and park in the lot just west of the causeway. Meet at 10:00 AM for a 5 to 6 mile hike. (M,NS,2.5). Leaders: Hank & Libby Moore (852-4717). (This hike will be repeated the next two Tuesdays in August.)
B. GARFIELD PARK - Each Tuesday in August there will be self-guided hikes of 4 miles and/or 5 miles (total of 9 miles) to begin at 5:30 PM. Park in the swimming pool parking lot at Garfield Park at east Raymond and Pleasant Run Parkway. (F,NS). Leaders: Bob & Marge Begeman (359-4174).
- AUG 8 (Saturday) DEAM WILDERNESS AREA - Assemble at 9:30 AM for a moderate to rugged 12 to 15 mile hike. Allow 2-1/2 hours travel time. Go SR 37 south to SR 46. Go east through Bloomington and turn right on SR 446. Cross the Monroe Reservoir causeway and go 4.3 miles further. Turn left on the road just past the Maumee Boy Scout sign. Go about 6 mile to the Fire Tower parking lot. Bring trail lunch and water. (H,NS,3). Leader: Al Drehobl (898-3632).
- AUG 9 (Sunday) TURKEY RUN STATE PARK - Allow 2 hours travel time. Go west on US 36 to Rockville, then north on US 41 to SR 47 and then east (right) about 2 miles to the Park entrance. (FEE). Meet in the parking lot for the hotel at 1:00 PM for a moderate hike of 7 to 8 miles (M,NS,3). Leader: Bill Larrison (359-7538).
- AUG 11 (Tuesday) A. EAGLE CREEK - WEST - See instructions for Aug 4.
B. GARFIELD PARK - See instructions for Aug 4.
- AUG 15 (Saturday) RUSTER PARK - Go one mile east on Washington Street from Washington Square to German Church Road. Go 1-1/2 miles south on German Church to Prospect, then 1/3 mile east to Ruster Park. Assemble in parking lot at 8:00 AM for a 7 mile hike. (F,PS,3). Leader: Ursula Breeding (359-8686).

- AUG 16 (Sunday) SHADES STATE PARK - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take I-74 west to the Jamestown exit. Go through Jamestown and follow SR 234 west to the Park entrance. (FEE). Meet in the picnic parking area at 2:00 PM for about 5 miles of moderate to rugged hiking. (NOTE: Keep to the left past the gate house). (H, NS, 3). Leader: Odie Cassetty (244-9913).
- AUG 18 (Tuesday) A. EAGLE CREEK - WEST - See instructions for Aug 4.
B. GARFIELD PARK - See instructions for Aug 4.
- AUG 22 (Saturday) MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign and go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. Turn left and drive to the fire tower parking lot for a hike of 10 to 12 miles, starting at 10:00 AM. (H, NS, 3). Leader: Al Drehobl (898-3632).
- AUG 23 (Sunday) SOUTHEASTWAY PARK - Meet at 7:00 AM for a 9 mile hike. Assemble in the parking lot at Southeastway Park, 5624 south on East County Line Road. (F, PS, 3). Leader: Ursula Breeding (359-8686).
- AUG 25 (Tuesday) A. EAGLE CREEK PARK - Meet at 10:00 AM in the parking lot just inside the 56th street gate for an easy 6 to 8 mile hike. (M, NS, 3). Leader: Mary Kidwell
B. GARFIELD PARK - See instructions for Aug 4. (852-2439).
- AUG 29 (Saturday) NOBSTONE TRAIL - DEAM LAKE TO NEW CHAPEL - Allow 2-1/2 hours travel time. Take I-65 south to the Henryville exit and go west on SR 160. About 1/3 mile west of New Liberty turn right onto an unmarked county road. (Watch for the KT sign post & sign for the New Chapel Church). Continue .4 mile to the New Chapel trailhead entrance road (gravel) to the right. Meet at 9:00 AM for a car shuttle. Bring lunch and liquid for a 17 mile hike. (NOTE: Bring extra liquid if the weather is hot). (H, NS, 3). Leader: Al Drehobl (898-3632).
- AUG 30 (Sunday) SPEEDWAY AREA HIKE - Meet at 2:00 PM in the Marsh parking lot, 5900 Crawfordsville Road for a 5 to 6 mile hike. (F, PS, 3). Leader: Wilma Thompson (241-7154)
- SEP 1 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK - WEST - Take west 56th Street to Eagle Creek Park and park in the lot just west of the causeway. Meet at 10:00 AM for a 5 to 6 mile hike. (M, NS, 2.5). Leaders: Hank & Libby Moore (852-4717).
- SEP 5 thru 7 (Saturday thru Monday) LABOR DAY WEEKEND AT NEW HARMONY (For members and their invited guests only). - SEP 7 (Monday) NORA NEIGHBORHOODS - Meet near south side of parking lot at Nora Plaza, 1300 East 86th Street at 7:30 AM for a hike of about 6 miles. Surface will be pavement, railbed, dirt paths, and pace variable. Leader: Dorothy Field (253-7114).
- SEP 8 (Tuesday) A. EAGLE CREEK - WEST - See instructions for Sept 1.
B. SPEEDWAY AREA - Meet between 5:15 and 5:30 PM in the Marsh parking lot, 5900 Crawfordsville Road for self-guided hikes of either 6 or 9 miles. Leader: Wilma Thompson. (241-7154). To be repeated on Tuesdays during September.
- SEP 10 (Thursday) GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND CLUB SOCIAL - (For members and their invited guests). Meet at 7:30 PM in the Fellowship Hall of the Covenant Presbyterian Church at 2305 North Kitley. (Park in rear and enter from the parking lot). DIRECTIONS: Kitley 6500 east, between Arlington and Shadeland. Take 21st Street to Kitley, then north to the second church on the right. This meeting includes the election of officers for the coming year effective October 1, 1987. The nominating committee of Ron Craig,

- SEP 12 (Saturday) MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign and go about 4 miles to the entrance. Turn left and drive 5 miles to the fire tower parking lot. Meet at 11:00 AM for a hike of about 9 to 10 miles. Bring lunch and water. (M,NS,3). Leader: Al Dreho1 (898-3632).
- SEP 13 (Sunday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Meet at 2:00 PM in the parking lot just inside the 56th Street entrance for a 6 to 8 mile hike. (M,NS, 3). Leaders: Mary & Win Pulsifer (784-1835).
- SEP 15 (Tuesday) A. EAGLE CREEK PARK - Meet at 10:00 AM in the parking lot inside the 56th Street entrance for a 5 to 7 mile hike. (M,NS, 3). Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439)

- SEP 19 (Saturday) JACKSON STATE FOREST - Allow 2 hours travel time from south side of Indianapolis. Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit, US 50 West. Go west on US 50 to Brownstown. Take SR 250 left about 3 miles to the Jackson State Forest entrance on the LEFT. Assemble in the parking lot beyond the lake at 9:00 AM for moderate to rugged hikes of 7 and 15 miles. Bring trail lunch & water. Leader: Al Dreho1(898-3632)
- SEP 20 (Sunday) SPEEDWAY LEVEE HIKE - Assemble at the Westwood Country Club at ^{10:00} 2:00 PM for an easy hike of about 4 miles. DIRECTIONS: From 6200 West 10th (just east of I-465) go north on Vinewood Drive one half block to High School Road. Turn left and follow High School Road north to the Country Club. (F,NS, 3). Leader: Odie Cassetty(244-9913)
Hike will cross an abandoned Railroad bridge.
- SEP 22 (Tuesday) A. EAGLE CREEK PARK - See instructions for Sept 15
B. SPEEDWAY AREA - See instructions for Sept 8.
- SEP 26 (Saturday) FOUR LAKES - ED CHAMBERS BIRTHDAY HIKE - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the Morgan-Monroe Forest sign and go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. There will be two hikes of about 8 miles each (approx. 14 to 16 miles total). IF YOU ARE GOING ON THE LONG HIKE, turn right and go to the parking lot for Bryant Creek Lake. IF YOU ARE GOING ON THE MORNING HIKE ONLY, drop your passengers at Bryant Creek and then continue about 2.6 miles to the road for Beanblossom Lake. Turn right and go a mile to the Lake parking area on the right. Be there by 9:40 AM to be shuttled back to the Bryant Creek area where the morning hike will begin at 10:00 AM. THOSE WHO WANT TO HIKE THE AFTERNOON HIKE ONLY should meet at the Beanblossom Lake parking area at 1:00 PM. You will be shuttled back to your cars at the end of the hike. All hikers bring lunch and liquid for lunch at Beanblossom Lake. (H,NS, 3). Leaders: Peg & Heydon Franzen (812-988-2461)
- SEP 27 (Sunday) DOWNTOWN/CANAL/WHITE RIVER STATE PARK - Assemble in the rear of All Saints Episcopal Church at 16th & Central Avenue for a 7 mile hike. Anyone wishing to go a shorter distance may do so. Hike to start at 1:00 PM. (F,PS, 2.5). Leader: Jim Stern (844-3791).
- SEP 29 (Tuesday) A. EAGLE CREEK PARK - Meet at 10:00 AM in the parking lot just inside the 56th Street entrance for a 5 to 7 mile hike. (M, NS, 3). Leaders: Mary & Win Pulsifer, (784-1835)

- OCT 3 and 4 (Saturday & Sunday) BACKPACK IN HOOSIER NATIONAL FOREST - Be sure to contact Libby Moore (852-4717) for reservations and information about this backpack. Take SR 37 south to Bloomington, then follow SR 46 east to SR 446. Turn right and go about 12 miles. About 1/2 mile past the Hardin Ridge sign you will come to the Tower Road on the left (just after the Maumee Boy Scout sign). Turn left and go about a mile to the Horsemen Camp. Meet there at 11:00 AM on Saturday.
- OCT 3 (Saturday) CATARACT FALLS FESTIVAL - Take I-70 west to the Cloverdale exit. Take US 231 south for about 7 miles to the sign for the Cataract Falls State Recreation Area. Turn right and go about 3 miles to the entrance. Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time. Meet at 10:30 AM for an easy to moderate hike of 6 & 12 miles. We will eat lunch in the village of Cataract where there will be a festival in progress. The entrees are HAM & BEANS and SLOPPY JOES. (M, NS & PS, 3) Leader: Jim Stern (844-3791).
- OCT 4 (Sunday) YORKTOWN - Take I-69 to Muncie/Anderson exit and follow SR 32 east to Yorktown. Turn right at the Dairy Queen, go about 2 blocks and park at the United Methodist Church parking lot on the south side of the street. Meet at 1:30 PM for an easy hike of 6 miles. (F, PS, 3). Leader: Cheryl Conwell (872-2583).
- OCT 6 (Tuesday) A. MORGAN-MONROE STATE FOREST - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel time. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the State Forest sign and go about 4 miles to the forest entrance. Turn left and drive to the fire tower parking lot for a moderate hike of about 5 miles. This hike will be repeated each Tuesday during October. Hike to start at 9:30 AM. (M, NS, 2.5). Leader: Bill Flora (898-0750).
- B. ELLENBERGER PARK - Meet at Ellenberger Park, 5400 block of East St. Clair Street, between 5:15 and 5:30 for a 4, 6, or 8 mile self-guided hike. This hike will be repeated each Tuesday in October. (F, PS) Leader: Ursula Breeding (359-8686).
- OCT 10 (Saturday) 30TH ANNIVERSARY STEW HIKE AT GNAW BONE CAMP - Come and help celebrate our 30th Anniversary Year with a hike and a hearty meal at Gnaw Bone Camp. Allow 1-1/2 hours driving time. Take SR 135 south to Nashville, turn left on SR 46 and go a couple of miles past the North Entrance to Brown County State Park to where SR 135 turns south. Go south on 135 a couple of miles to the Gnaw Bone Camp entrance. The hike will start at 9:30 AM and the meal of Stew, Cornbread, drinks, etc. will be at 1:30 PM. COST: \$4.00 per person. This includes camp fee and part of the cost of the meal. The Hiking Club is paying the balance of the cost. This amount will be payable at the Camp. However in order to plan for the number of people, it is important that you call Bill Larrison (359-7538) to reserve space. We need to inform the cooks at the Camp as to the number of people to expect. LET'S HAVE A BIG TURNOUT IN CELEBRATION OF OUR 30TH ANNIVERSARY YEAR. The longest hike will be about 10 miles, with shorter hikes available. (H, NS, 3).
