- DEC 3 (Saturday) ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARTY - (For members and their invited guests)
PLACE; PRENTICE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, 4900 East 38th Street (One block west of Emerson Avenue on north side of 38th St.). Park in rear parking lot and meeting room is in basement on East side of Church. ARRIVAL TIME: Plan to arrive about 6:00 PM and the old fashioned pitch-in dinner will begin at 6:30 PM. Bring food to contribute to the buffet table according to the size of your family group - enough for hearty appetites. An entree, a covered dish, a dessert, a salad, bread, or a snack or two - the choice is up to you. Bring your own plates and silverware and cups. The Club will furnish hot and cold drinks and table coverings and napkins. Our entertainment will be musical in keeping with the season from the "New Beginnings" featuring Paul & Debbie Dunham with their renditions of old favorites. Santa Claus will probably be there too.
- EC 3 (Saturday) (A) CROSLY STATE FISH & GAME PRESERVE - Take I-65 south to SR 46, (Columbus exit) to SR 7 southeast through North Vernon to approximately 5 miles south on SR 3. Allow 1-3/4 hours travel time from I-465. Meet in the parking lot at 8:30 AM for hikes of 12 & 17 miles. Some off trail and cross country. Possible wet and muddy areas. 3 mile per hour pace to allow those wishing to attend the Christmas Party time to return to Indianapolis. Bring lunch & water. (M,NS,3) Leader: Al Drehobl (898-3632)
(B) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Assemble at the Amphitheatre past the Indian Museum at 9:30 AM for a 7 mile hike. (M,NS,2.5-3). Leaders: Hank & Libby Moore(852-4717)
- DEC 4 (Sunday) (A) AROUND MARION COUNTY - Meet at 8:00 AM at West 10th Street and Raceway Road in the parking lot of Gillespie Florist for a self-guided hike of 25 miles. Shorter options possible. Bring food & water. (F,PS). Leader: Dennis Taft (271-7118)
(B) CHRISTMAS IN THE VILLAGE OF ZIONSVILLE - Allow 3/4 hours travel from downtown. Meet in Lions Park northside of SR 334, just east of Main Street at 1:00 PM for a 5 mile hike. The stores & specialty shops will be open until 5:00 PM. Many will serve refreshments. Santa & carolers will be roaming the streets. (F,PS,3). Leader: Charlotte Malott (873-5270).
- DEC 6 (Tuesday) FALL CREEK ETC - Meet at Windridge Center, 5500 N. Emerson Way, parking in front of shops but close to duck pond, for a 6 mile hike starting at 9:30 AM. (F,NS&P,3). Leader: Dorothy Field (253-7114).
- DEC 10 (Saturday) NORTHWILLOW COLLEGE PARK - Assemble at 86th & Township Line Road behind Shapiro's Restaurant at 9:00 AM for 5 or 10 mile hikes. Lunch available at Shapiro's. (F,PS,2.5-3). Leader: Gerry O-Reilly (846-0657)
- EC 11 (Sunday) (A) VERNON, INDIANA - Allow 1-1/2 hour travel and park at Jennings County Court House for 6 or 12 mile hikes starting at 11:00 AM. (M,PS,2.5) Leader: Jim Stern (844-3791)
(B) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Assemble at 56th St. parking area at 2:00 PM for a 5 mile hike. (M,NS,2.5) Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717)

- DEC 13 (Tuesday) FALL CREEK, ETC. - See instructions for Dec 6th. (Different hike)
- DEC 17 (Saturday) (A) DEAM WILDERNESS AREA - Assemble at 9:00 AM for a moderate to rugged hike of 15 or more miles depending upon weather and trail conditions. Some cross country and some off-trail. Allow 2-1/2 hours travel. Take SR 37 south to SR 46. (Bloomington exit). Go east on SR 46 through Bloomington and turn right on SR 446. Cross Monroe Causeway and continue 4.3 miles. Turn left on Tower Ridge Road (just past the Maumee Boy Scout sign). Go about 6 miles to the fire tower parking lot. Bring lunch & water. (M,NS,3). Leader: Al Drehobl (898-3632).
- (B) BACON SWAMP & ARSENAL PARK - Go west from Keystone on 54th Street about one block to the parking lot between Waffle House & Arsenal Savings. Park close to the street. Meet at 9:00 AM for an easy hike of 7 to 9 miles. (F,HS,2.5-3). Leader: Harrison Feldman (251-0562).
- DEC 18 (Sunday) (A) CROOKED CREEK-WRECKER HIKE - Meet at 9:30 AM for a 12 or more mile hike. Allow 1-3/4 hours travel. Bring lunch & water. From Nashville go west on SR 46 for approx. 3 miles past the west entrance to the Park, or 1/2 mile past the entrance to "Ski World". Look for a group of buildings on the north side (2 trailers, a log house, a small house & one other building). Turn south on a gravel road just opposite this area and go 2.7 miles to the Crooked Creek parking area on the left. Look carefully for the parking area; - it is easy to pass. (M,NS,3). - (B) BUTLER UNIVERSITY - Meet at 2:30 PM in the parking lot east of the Library on Sunset Avenue just south of 46th Street for an easy 5 to 6 mile hike. (F,HS,2.5). Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717).
- DEC 20 (Tuesday) BROAD RIPPLE - CANAL - Meet at 9:30 AM in the parking lot over the Canal just east of College for hikes of 4 or 8 miles. (F,HS,3). Leader: Tom Patterson(849-9528)
- DEC 24 (Saturday) (A) AROUND HENDRICKS COUNTY - Meet at 8:30 AM in Stilesville for a self-guided hike of 11 or 19 miles. Take US 40 west to Stilesville and turn right on Morgan Street. Park at the little Park about a block off US 40. Bring food and water. (F,PS). Leader: Dennis Taft (271-7118).
- (B) WHITE RIVER - CANAL - Meet in the lot on White River Parkway, West Drive, just north of 30th Street at 9:30 AM for hikes of 4 or 8 miles. (F,PS,2.5). Leader: Bob Corya (297-3926).
- DEC 25 (Sunday) ELLENBERGER PARK CHRISTMAS HIKE - Meet at 3:00 PM in the parking lot near the swimming pool/ice rink at Ellenberger Park, 5400 block of East St. Clair and 800 North Ritter Ave. for a 6 mile hike. (F,PS,3-3.5). Leaders: Marge & Bob Begeman (359-4174).
- DEC 27 (Tuesday) BROAD RIPPLE - CANAL - See instructions for Dec 20th.
- DEC 31 (Saturday) RACING AROUND THE SPEEDWAY - Meet at the Kohl Parking lot, 5660 Crawfordsville Road, in the Speedway Mall at 9:30 AM for hikes of 4, 6, 8, 10 or 12 miles. (F,PS,3.5). Leader: Avis Shipman (247-9498).
- JAN 1 (Sunday) BROAD RIPPLE - CANAL - Meet at 9:30 AM in the parking lot over the canal just east of College Ave. for hikes of 4 or 8 miles. (F,HS,3.5). Leader: Tom Patterson (849-9528)
- JAN 2 (Monday) GREEK ORTHODOX CHURCH - Park along the street at 40th & Pennsylvania at 10:00 AM for 5 or more miles of hiking each Monday morning in January. (F,PS,2.5) Leader: Joe Wilhelm (241-3695).
- JAN 3 (Tuesday) BRADFORD WOODS - Take SR 67 southwest to about 8 miles past Gray's Cafeteria in Mooresville. Turn right into Bradford Woods and continue to the office parking lot. Follow signs to the Office. Meet at 10:00 AM for a moderate hike of 5 miles. (M,NS,2.5-3). Leader: Sam Lloyd (241-3557). To be repeated each Tuesday in January. (NOTE: There will be a \$1.00 Camp Fee)

- JAN 7 (Saturday) SOUTHEASTERN HAMILTON COUNTY - Assemble at 8:30 AM at the entrance to Sahn Park, .7 miles east of Allisonville Road on 91st Street for 10 or 20 mile hikes. (F,PS,3.5). Leader: Karen Carrell (849-5488)
- JAN 8 (Sunday) (A) BROWN COUNTY STATE PARK - Meet at the fire tower in Brown County Park at 8:00 AM for a rugged and fast hike of 15 miles. Bring trail lunch and water. (H,NS&PS, 3-3.5). Leader: Pat Foreman (255-7305).
(B) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Assemble at the Amphitheatre near the Indian Museum at 2:00 PM for 5 to 6 mile hike. (M,NS,2.5). Leader: Mary Pulsifer (784-1835).
- JAN 9 (Monday) GREEK ORTHODOX CHURCH - See instructions for Jan 2nd.
- JAN 10 (Tuesday) BRADFORD WOODS - See instructions for Jan 3rd.
- JAN 14 (Saturday) FALL CREEK CANAL - WHITE RIVER - Meet at 9:00 AM in the parking lot north of the State Capitol at Ohio & Capitol for a moderate 7 mile hike. (F,HS,3-3.5). Leader: Marge Begeman (359-4174).
- JAN 15 (Sunday) (A) AROUND HENDRICKS COUNTY - Meet at 8:00 AM at West 10th and Raceway Road in parking lot of Gillespie Florist for a self-guided hike of 12, 20, or 26 miles. Food & water are available about 2/3 of the way thru the long hike. (F,PS). Leader: Dennis Taft (271-7118). *120 with options of 12*
(B) PRINCESS LAKES HIKE - 1-1/2 hours travel. Take SR 135 south, then east on SR 252 to Nineveh and follow the signs to Princess Lakes. About 3 miles south of Nineveh you turn right and then immediately to the left. Park at the liquor store parking lot. Meet at 1:00 PM for hikes of 4 or 7 miles. (M,PS,3). Leader: Joe Wilhelm (241-3695).
- JAN 16 (Monday) GREEK ORTHODOX CHURCH - See instructions for Jan 2nd.
- JAN 17 (Tuesday) BRADFORD WOODS - See instructions for Jan 3rd.
- JAN 21 (Saturday) OLIO ROAD - Go northeast on Pendleton Pike (SR 67) to McCordsville. Turn north (left) on 600 W and proceed approx 3 miles to the bridge over Geist Reservoir. Before crossing the bridge pull off to the east (right) and park at the Sand & Gravel Co. parking lot. Easy road hike of 9 miles to start at 10:00 AM. (F,PS,3.25). Leader: Ron Craig (255-6215).
- JAN 22 (Sunday) GREENFIELD HIKE - An easy hike of 7 miles touring the southside of Greenfield, including the Country Club Golf Course. Hike starts at 1:30 PM at Riley Park swimming pool parking lot. Take I-70 east to SR 9 (Greenfield/Maxwell exit). Turn right and drive 3 blocks to 200 N. Turn left and proceed seven blocks to 250E. Turn right and drive 1.7 miles to the parking lot on the right. (There are no restrooms here). (F,PS, 3.5). Leader: John Behrmann (462-7058).
- JAN 23 (Monday) GREEK ORTHODOX CHURCH - See instructions for Jan 2nd.
- JAN 24 (Tuesday) BRADFORD WOODS - See instructions for Jan 3rd.
- JAN 28 (Saturday) AROUND HENDRICKS COUNTY - Meet at 8:00 AM at Brownsburg Square in front of the K-Mart for a self-guided hike of 17 or 25 miles. Take I-74 west to the Brownsburg exit and go south to the parking lot. Bring food and water. (F,PS). Leader: Dennis Taft (271-7118).
