PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BY-LAWS - (To be voted on at the General Assembly on March 9th.)
This proposed amendment abolishes the 10¢ per person hiking fee. Because of the number of hikes which the Club now schedules, the forwarding of hike fees to the treasurer has become quite a burden to hike leaders, as well as increased bookkeeping for the treasurer. We feel that this old tradition of the Club has served its purpose and it is now time to make a change. Dues will probably be increased next year to offset this loss of income.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

SECTION 6 is amended to read as follows:

SEC. 6. SPECIAL FEES

- (a) The trip fee of 10¢ is abolished effective October 1, 1989.
- (b) A registration fee of 50¢ shall be collected from all adults on all scheduled Club overnight outings. This money is to be remitted to the Club treasurer to help defray costs incurred on overnights.

- ✓ FEB 4 (Saturday) ✓ (A) HALF-CENTURY HIKE - I - Today and tomorrow there will be hikes of 25 miles with shorter options available. Assemble in the Statehouse parking lot at 8:00 AM each day. (F,PS,3.5+) Leader: Tom Patterson (849-9528)
✓ (B) CARMEL HIKE - Meet at 8:30 AM at Carmel Junior High School, approximately one mile east of Keystone on 126th Street, for 5 or 10 miles of hiking. (F,PS,2.5). Leader: Tom Bowers (846-5362).
- ✓ FEB 5 (Sunday) (A) ✓ HALF-CENTURY HIKE - II - See instructions for February 4th (A).
(B) ✓ ELLENBERGER PARK - Meet at 8:00 AM in the parking lot near the swimming pool at Ellenberger Park, 5400 East St. Clair St. and 800 North Ritter, for an easy 10 mile hike. (F,PS,3). Leaders: Marge & Bob Begeman (359-4174).
- FEB 7 (Tuesday) ✓ EAGLE CREEK PARK - Assemble near the Amphitheatre at 10:00 AM for a easy 5 to 6 mile hike. To be repeated each Tuesday during February. (M,NS,3).
Leaders: Mary & Win Pulsifer (784-1835).
- FEB 8 (Wednesday) ✓ DOWNTOWN HIKE - Meet at the State Capitol Rotunda on the second floor at noon for a hike of about 3 miles. We will hike inside the State Capitol Building, the State Library, and the State Office Building through tunnels and using many staircases during the lunch hour. (F,HS,3). - FEB 10,11,12 (Friday, Saturday, Sunday) WINTER WEEKEND AT POKAGON STATE PARK - (For members and their invited guests) The rooms the Club reserved at the Inn have all been taken. However some members are staying in nearby motels. If interested, please call Bill Larrison for information and telephone of adjacent motels. (359-7538). Complete schedule of our events will be given out on your arrival at the Park, for those who have made reservations.
- FEB 11 (Saturday) CROWN HILL CEMETERY - Enter through the gate on Clarendon Road just north of W. 38th Street, and park on the driveway behind the Mausoleum. A 5 mile hike to begin at 1:30 PM and will include the Gothic Chapel as well as other points of interest. (F,PS,2.5) Leader: Edward Arrowsmith (846-3098).
- FEB 12 (Sunday) "NORTHWEST PASSAGE" - Assemble at 9:30 AM at Aqua Pools Station, 84th St. and Lafayette Road for a 9 mile road hike. (F,PS,3.5) Leader: Bob Corya (297-3926)
- FEB 14 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See instructions for February 7th.
- FEB 15 (Wednesday) TOUR OF STATE CAPITOL BUILDING - Meet at 1:30 PM at the Rotunda Desk in the lobby of the State House for a guided tour of the renovated State House followed by a 2 mile slow & easy hike. (F,PS,2.5) Leaders: Albert Neill (634-7672) and Juanita Lauth (353-6325). NOTE: Parking for our cars is provided in the parking lot south of the Ramada Inn. located on West Washington Street at West Street. This lot is the overflow State House parking lot and the guard there will tell you where to park. BE SURE TO MARK YOUR CAR WITH THE FOLLOWING: (State House tour at 1:30 PM - Phone 232-9410)
- FEB 18 (Saturday) (A) MORGAN-MONROE - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the sign for Morgan-Monroe and go about 4 miles to the entrance. Turn left and drive to the fire tower parking lot. Meet 9:00 AM for a 12 mile hike. Bring lunch & water. (H,NS,2.5-3) Leader: Bill Boyd
(B) LUPUI - Go west on Michigan Street past the School of Dentistry to Lansing Street. Turn left and go to New York Street. Turn left again and park in the first parking lot on the left. Easy 5 mile hike starting at 1:00 PM. (F,PS,2.5-3). Leader: Joe Lehman (297-1632). (297-4941)
- FEB 19 (Sunday) ZIONSVILLE - Allow 3/4 hour travel from downtown. Meet in Lions Park, north side of SR 334, just east of Main Street at 8:00 AM for hikes of 5 and 10 miles. Bring water. (F,PS,3). Leader: Charlotte Malott (873-5270).
- FEB 21 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See instructions for February 7th.
- FEB 25 (Saturday) (A) AROUND THE COUNTY - Meet at 7:30 AM at Ivyway Plaza at 71st Street and Graham Road for a self-guided hike of 20 miles. (Ivyway Plaza is one block west of SR 37 and 71st Street. Park close to 71st Street) Bring food and water for this road hike. Shorter options of 12 and 16 miles. (F,PS). Leader: Dennis Taft (271-7118).
(B) SPEEDWAY LEVEE HIKE - Meet at the Westwood Country Club at 10:00 AM for an easy hike of 4 to 5 miles. Westwood is on High School Road north of 10th St. From 6200 West 10th (just east of I-465) go north on Vinewood 1/2 block to High School Road. Turn left and go north to the Club. (F,NS/PS,2.5). Leader: Odie Cassetty (244-9913)
- FEB 26 (Sunday) "ZIONSVILLE SURPRISE" - Allow 3/4 hour travel from downtown. Meet in Lions Park on the north side of SR 334 just east of Main Street at 8:00 AM for hikes of 5 and 10 miles. Bring water. (F,PS,3). Leader: Charlotte Malott (873-5270)
- FEB 28 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See instructions for February 7th.
- MAR 4 (Saturday) BUTLER UNIVERSITY HIKE - Assemble in the parking lot of the Velodrome, 3649 Cold Spring Road, at 9:30 AM for a 12 mile hike. (F,PS,3). Leader: Sham Mueller (271-8185)

- MAR 5 (Sunday) ✓ GLENDALE TO THE CIRCLE - Meet at Glendale Shopping Center on the east side of Rural Street at 8:00 AM for hikes of 9 or 18 miles. We will assemble at 17 W. Market Street for the return hike. Hikers going only one way are responsible for arranging their transportation. (F,PS,3+). Leader: Thomas Patterson (849-9528).
- MAR 6 (Monday) ✓ RILEY HOSPITAL - Meet at 2:00 PM in the atrium of Riley Hospital for a guided tour of the Hospital, followed by a 2 mile slow & easy hike. (F,PS,2.5) Leaders: Alberta Neill (634-7672) and Juanita Lauth (353-6325).
- MAR 7 (Tuesday) ✓ MORGAN-MONROE FOREST - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the Morgan-Monroe sign and go about 4 miles to the entrance. Turn left and drive to the fire tower parking lot. Meet at 9:30 AM for a moderate hike of 5 miles. (M,NS,2.5). Leaders: Mary Kidwell (852-2439) and Bill Flora (898-0760). This hike to be repeated each Tuesday in March.
- MAR 9 (Thursday) ✓ GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND CLUB SOCIAL - (For members and their invited guests) Meet at 7:30 PM in the Social Hall of the Christ Presbyterian Church at 4900 East 38th Street (one block west of Emerson on north side of street). Park in the rear parking lot and go down the steps to the meeting room in basement. The business meeting will include voting on the Proposed Amendment to the By-Laws (See first page of this schedule). An interesting program has been planned by the Social Officer and refreshments will be served.
- MAR 11 (Saturday) ✓ LAKE HART - Take I-70 west to the Monrovia exit (SR 39). Follow SR 39 south to the Monrovia High School. Park in the school lot. This 13 mile hike will start at 8:30 AM. Shorter options available. (F,HS,3). Leader: Carol Ernsting (257-7146)
- MAR 12 (Sunday) ✓ COVERED BRIDGES OVER FLAT ROCK RIVER - Meet at 9:30 AM for a 6 or 14 mile hike over country roads. Allow one hour travel. Take I-74 southeast past Shelbyville to SR 244 (exit 119). Go east on SR 244 for 7 miles (or 3-1/2 miles past the Shelby County line sign). Turn south on road 640-W for one mile to Moscow, IN. Meet near covered bridge in center of Moscow. Bring lunch & water. (F,HS,3.) Leaders: Marge & Bob Begeman (359-4174).
- MAR 14 (Tuesday) ✓ MORGAN-MONROE FOREST - See instructions for March 7th.
- MAR 15 (Wednesday) ✓ DOWNTOWN - Meet at 12:00 Noon on the south side of Monument Circle for a FAST lunchtime hike of 2 to 3 miles in the downtown area. (F,PS,3-3.5). Leader: Pat Foreman (255-7305).
- MAR 18 (Saturday) ✓ TURKEY TRACK HIKE - Allow 1-1/4 hours travel. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the sign up the hill for Morgan-Monroe, and go a short distance to a shelter house. (DO NOT DRIVE ALL THE WAY TO MORGAN-MONROE FOREST). The shelter house is only a short distance from SR 37. Meet at 9:30 AM for a 12 or 18 mile hike. Bring lunch & water. (M,NS/HS,3-3.5). Leader: Charles Hodges (787-3798)
- MAR 19 (Sunday) ✓ SHANNON LAKE - Meet at 1:30 PM at the southwest corner of SR 37 and Banta Road for 5 or 9 mile road hikes. Banta is 6500 south. (F,PS,2.5to3.5). Leader: Bob Pedigo (887-2391).
- MAR 21 (Tuesday) ✓ MORGAN-MONROE FOREST - See instructions for March 7th.
- MAR 24 (Friday) ✓ GOOD FRIDAY AT MORGAN-MONROE - See driving instructions for March 7th hike. Meet at the fire tower at 9:00 AM for hikes of 9, 16, or 20 miles. Longer hikes will be moderate to rugged in spots. Bring lunch & water. (H,NS,3). Leader: Al Drebobl (898-3632)
- MAR 25 (Saturday) ✓ EASTER SURPRISE" - Assemble at 9:00 AM in the parking lot at the northwest corner of SR 37 and 71st St opposite Acapulco Joe's for a 5, 10, and 15 mile hike. (F,PS,3.5). Leader: Thomas Patterson (849-9528).

- MAR 26 (Sunday) ✓(A) WASHINGTON'S DRUMMER BOY - Meet at 1:00 PM in the parking lot at the southeast corner of 5500 South Meridian and Epler (Note: this is one block west of the four lane SR 135 highway). This 8 mile hike will include a stop at Adrian's Orchard for cider. (F,PS,2.5). Leader: Bob Pedigo (887-2391).
- (B) ✓GARFIELD PARK EASTER HIKE - Meet at the parking lot beside the swimming pool in Garfield Park (2450 Shelby) at 2:00 PM for an easy 4 mile hike including a visit to the conservatory to see the Easter flowers, (F,NS/PS,2.5) Leaders: Win & Mary Pulsifer (784-1835).
- MAR 28 (Tuesday) ✓MORGAN-MONROE FOREST - See instructions for March 7th.
- APR 1 (Saturday) ✓(A) WHITEWATER GORGE & EARLHAM COLLEGE - Take I-70 east to Richmond and exit at SR 27 south. This is also called Chester Blvd. Go south to the first automatic signal, turn right onto Waterfall Road. Go 1/2 mile to the entrance to Springwood Park. Meet at 9:30 AM for hikes of 8 or 11 miles. Park near the public restrooms. Bring lunch & water. (M,HS,2.5-3). Leaders: Mabel Voyles (253-2355), Louise Crandall (251-7890), and Wilma Thompson (241-7154).
- (B) ✓THREE LAKES HIKE - Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles past Martinsville, turn left at the sign for Morgan-Monroe and go about 4 miles to the entrance. Turn left and go to the Cherry Lake Shelter. Meet at 8:30 AM for a 10 mile hike. Bring lunch & water. (M,NS,3-3.5). Leader: Pat Foreman (255-7305).
