JUN 3 (Saturday) (A) NOBSTONE TRAIL - DEAM LAKE TO NEW CHAPEL - Allow 2½ hours travel. Take I-65 south to the Henryville exit and go west on SR 160. About 1/3 mile west of New Liberty turn right onto an unmarked country road. (Watch for the KT sign post & sign for the New Chapel church). Continue .4 mile to the Trailhead entrance road (gravel) to the right. Meet at 9:00AM for a car shuttle. Bring lunch & water for a rugged 17 mile hike. (H,NS,3). Leader: Al Drehobl (898-3632). (EXTRA WATER IF HOT)
BRING 2 LITERS OF WATER
(B) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Assemble near the Amphitheatre at 9:00 AM for an easy 5 to 6 mile hike. (M,NS,2.5-3). Leaders: Hank & Libby Moore (852-4717).

JUN 4 (Sunday) WHITE RIVER - CANAL - Meet in the lot on White River Parkway, W. Drive, just north of 30th St. at 2:00 PM for an easy 5 to 6 mile hike. (F,HS,2.5). Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717).

JUN 6 (Tuesday) (A) SPEEDWAY VARIETY - Meet at 9:00 AM in the Marsh Parking Lot (5900 Crawfordville Road, across from the Speedway Shopping Center) for a 5 to 6 mile hike. To be repeated each Tuesday in June. (F,NS&PS,3). Leaders: Wilma Thompson (241-7154), and Barbara Tipton (241-7953).

(B) ELLENBERGER PARK - Meet at 5:30 PM each Tuesday in June in the parking lot near the swimming pool at Ellenberger Park, 5400 block of East St. Clair St. and 800 N. Ritter Ave. for 4 or 8 mile self-guided hikes, (F,HS). Leaders: Marge and Bob Begeman (359-4174).

JUN 7 (Wednesday) ZIGGING & ZAGGING THROUGH ZIONSVILLE - Allow 3/4 hour travel from downtown. Meet in Lions Park, north side of SR 334 just east of Main Street at 6:00 PM for a self-guided hike of 5 miles to be repeated each Wednesday in June. (F,HS). Leader: Charlotte Malott (873-5270).

JUN 10 (Saturday) (A) NOBSTONE TRAIL (BACK COUNTRY LOOP) - Allow 2-1/2 hours travel. Take I-65 south to Seymour exit, and go west on US 50 through Brownstown. Take SR 135 south about 9.1 miles and turn left just after the Muscatatuck River bridge. Follow Delaney Park signs. Go past Delaney Park a short distance and turn left at the sign for Spurgeon Hollow. Park near the lake at 10:00 AM for a moderate to rugged hike of about 15 miles. Bring lunch & water. (M,NS,3). Leaders: Don Holden (293-0547) and A.T. Mulberry (291-9979)

- JUN 10 (Saturday) (B) FORT HARRISON VOLKSMARCH - Take 56th Street east of I-465 into Fort Harrison. Follow directional arrows to the Outdoor Recreational Center on Glenn Rd. Meet hike leader at 9:00 AM. After signing roster, go to the starting point table and receive card. You may care to traverse this ten kilometer (6.2 mile) hike more than once. (F,NS). Leader: Gerry O-Reilly (846-0657).
- JUN 11 (Sunday) (A) FORT HARRISON VOLKSMARCH - See directions for yesterday's volksmarch, as it is being continued today. Leader: Gerry O-Reilly (846-0657) (Sign up at 9:00 AM)
(B) MOORESVILLE HIKE - Take SR 67 south to Mooresville. Turn right at Gray's cafeteria, go about 1/2 block and turn left into the shopping center parking lot. Meet at 2:00 PM for an easy 5 to 6 mile hike. (F,PS,2.5). Leader: Pat Eckstein (996-2597).
- JUN 13 (Tuesday) (A) SPEEDWAY VARIETY - See instructions for June 6 (A)

- JUN 14 (Wednesday) ZIGGING & ZAGGING THROUGH ZIONSVILLE - See instructions for June 7.
- JUN 17 (Saturday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - EAST & WEST - Take 56th Street west to Eagle Creek Park and park in the lot just west of the Causeway. Meet at 8:30 AM for a moderately rugged hike of about 13 miles. Bring lunch & water plus 25¢ for walk-in fee to the Park. Shorter options NOT available. (M,NS,2.5-3). Leader: Libby Moore (852-4717)
- JUN 18 (Sunday) ZIONSVILLE HIKE - Assemble at the Lions Park on the north side of SR 334 just east of Main Street at 1:30 PM for 5 or 10 mile hikes. Bring water. (F,PS,3). Leader: Charlotte Malott (873-5270).

- JUN 24 (Saturday) SWEETWATER & CORDRY LAKES - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel. Take SR 135 south to SR 252. Go east on 252 to signs for Nineveh. Turn right and go south through Nineveh for about 7.5 miles. Follow "Church of the Lakes" signs. Use caution on the narrow roads. Park near the saleshouse. Self-guided hikes of 5, 8, 10 and 14 miles begin at 10:00 AM. Bring lunch & water. (M,PS) Leader: Joe Wilhelm (241-3695).
- JUN 25 (Sunday) HISTORIC FOUNTAIN SQUARE - Assemble in the parking lot beside the Garfield Park swimming pool at 2450 Shelby Street at 1:30 PM for an easy 5 mile hike. (F,PS2.5) Leader: Estella Perkins (638-0697). To be repeated on July 23rd.

- JUN 28 (Wednesday) ZIGGING & ZAGGING THROUGH ZIONSVILLE - See instructions for June 7
- JUL 1 (Saturday) LIEBER STATE RECREATION AREA - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel. Take I-70 west to the SR 243 exit. Go south to the Park (Fee). Meet at 1:30 PM in the picnic parking area which is the left fork near the end of the road to the beach. Easy to moderate 6 miles. (F,NS,2.5-3). Leader: Bill Larrison (359-7538).
- JUL 2 (Sunday) DOWNTOWN VIA WOODRUFF PLACE - Meet at 1:30 PM at O'Malia's Food Market, 320 N. New Jersey St. in the east parking lot for a 7 mile hike. (F,PS,2.5) Leader: Jim Stern (844-3791).
- JUL 4 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - Assemble near the Nature Center at 9:00 AM for a moderate 5 to 6 mile hike to be repeated each Tuesday in July. (M,NS,2.5). Leaders: Wilma Thompson (241-7154) and Barbara Tipton (241-7953).

- JUL 6 (Thursday) BROAD RIPPLE CANAL - Meet in the parking lot over the canal east of College Ave. at 5:30 PM for 5 or 8 mile hikes which are self-guided. To be repeated each Thursday in July. (F,PS). Leader: Alice Stalcup (897-1852).
- JUL 8 (Saturday) MORGAN RAIDERS FESTIVAL - Take I-65 south to the 2nd Columbus exit (SR 46). Go east to SR 7 and south to Dupont which is about 10 miles south of North Vernon. Park in the area of the Dupont State Bank to the left of SR 7 and across the railroad tracks. This 7 mile hike will start at 10:00 AM. Allow 1-3/4 hours travel from the south side. (F,PS,2.5). Leader: Jim Stern (844-3791).
- JUL 9 (Sunday) (A) ZIONSVILLE HIKE - Assemble at Lions Park on the north side of SR 334 just east of Main Street at 8:00 AM for an 11 mile "llama loop" hike returning to Lions Park at about 11:30 AM, with the option of continuing for another 10 miles. Afternoon hikers are welcome to sign in at about 12:00 noon for the afternoon hike beginning at 12:00 PM. Thus, there are two sign-in times, one at 8:00 AM and one at 12:00 noon (F,PS,3). Leader: Charlotte Malott (873-5270). Bring water. Note: there are no restrooms enroute.
- (B) BROWN COUNTY STATE PARK - Allow 2 hours travel. Take SR 135 south through Nashville to the Park (Fee). Meet at 10:00 AM in the parking lot for the Nature Center for an 8 to 9 mile hike. Bring lunch & water (H,NS,2.5). Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439).
- JUL 11 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See instructions for July 4
- JUL 13 (Thursday) BROAD RIPPLE CANAL - See instructions for July 6.
- JUL 15 (Saturday) MARY GRAY BIRD SANCTUARY - Allow 2 hours travel. Take SR 52 southeast to Rushville, then east on SR 44 about 11 miles to a sign for Mary Gray. Turn right on 525-W and go south to a "T". Turn left and go a short distance to the first road to the right (450-W). Turn right and go a couple of miles to the entrance to Mary Gray on the right. (Watch closely as you come to the entrance suddenly just as the road curves to the left). Meet at 10:30 AM for an 8 mile hike. (Shorter options). (F,NS,2.5-3). Leader: Bill Larrison (359-7538).
- JUL 16 (Sunday) CARMEL HIKE = Meet at 1:00 PM near the Woodland Theater at Keystone Shopping Center at 116th and Keystone for an easy 6 and 12 mile hikes. (F,PS,2.5). Leader: Jim Stern (844-3791).
- JUL 18 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See instructions for July 4.
- JUL 20 (Thursday) BROAD RIPPLE CANAL - See instructions for July 6.
- JUL 22 (Saturday) ANNUAL SUMMER PICNIC - (For members and their invited guests). The Club has reserved Shelter "B" at Eagle Creek Park. Follow the signs in the Park to the Shelter and park in the area nearby. There will be a hike starting at 10:00 AM. We plan to eat about 1:00 PM. Bring food to contribute to the old-fashioned pitch-in picnic. Protect your food from the heat with ice chests. Bring your own table service. Also a folding chair or two. The social committee is working on various games and other picnic activities.
- JUL 23 (Sunday) (A) HISTORIC FOUNTAIN SQUARE - See instructions for June 25.
- (B) VERSAILLES STATE PARK - Allow 2 hours travel. Take I-74 southeast to the Greensburg exit (SR 421). Follow 421 south to Versailles and go east on US 50 a couple of miles to the Park (Fee). Meet in the picnic parking area near the campground at 1:00 PM for a moderate to rugged hike of about 7 to 8 miles. (M,NS,2.5-3). Leader: Bill Larrison (359-7538).

JUL 25 (Tuesday) EAGLE CREEK PARK - See instructions for July 4.

JUL 27 (Thursday) BROAD RIPPLE CANAL - See instructions for July 6.

JUL 29 (Saturday) ^(A) WABASH HERITAGE TRAIL - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel. Take I-65 north SR 43 and exit at West Lafayette. Turn left toward West Lafayette and go a short distance (about 500 feet) and again turn left onto N. 9th Street. Drive 1.6 miles to Tippecanoe Battlefield parking lot on the left. Meet at 10:00 AM for 14 to 16 mile hike, over completed portion of trail. Bring lunch and water. (F,NS,3). Leader: John Behrmann (462-7058).

(B) SHADES STATE PARK - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel. Take I-74 west to Jamestown exit. Go through Jamestown and follow SR 234 west to the Park (Fee). Meet at 2:00 PM in the main picnic parking area at end of the road to the left past the gate house. Moderate to rugged 5 to 7 miles. (H,NS,2.5-3). Leader: Mary Kidwell (852-2439).

JUL 30 (Sunday) SPRING MILL STATE PARK - Allow 2 hours travel. Take SR 37 south to Mitchell then east on SR 60 a couple of miles to the Park (Fee). Meet at 1:00 PM in the parking lot for the Pioneer Village for a 7 to 8 mile hike. (Shorter options). (M,NS2.5). Leader: Bill Larrison (359-7538).
