- OCT 1 (Tuesday) (A) MORGAN-MONROE FOREST - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the Morgan-Monroe sign and go about 4 miles to the entrance. Turn left and drive about 5 miles to the fire tower parking lot for a moderate hike of 5 miles starting at 9:00 AM. To be repeated each Tuesday in October. (M,NS,2.5). Leaders: Bill Flora (898-0760) and Mary Kidwell (852-2439)
- (B) WARREN CENTRAL - Take I-70 east to the Post Road exit. Go south to 21st St and turn left (east) to the street before the Warren Library. Turn right and follow to a "T" in the road. Park in the lot almost behind the Walker Career Center at 5:30 PM for a 3 or 7 mile self-guided hike. To be repeated each Tuesday in October. (F,PS). Leader: Rick Kinnaman (861-3979).
- OCT 2 (Wednesday) (A) WALKER THEATER TOUR - (617 Indiana Ave.) Meet at 1:45 PM at parking lot north of the Walker Theater. Tour to begin at 2:00 PM. (Fees - Children \$1.00, Seniors \$1.00, other adults \$2.00.) After the tour there will be a 2 mile slow & easy hike. (F,PS,2.5) Leaders: Alberta Neill (634-7672) and Ruth Overpeck (356-0135).

- OCT 5 (Saturday) SALAMONIE SNOWMOBILE TRAIL - Allow 2 hours travel. Take I-69 north and exit on SR 5 (Huntington/Warren exit). Go north for a mile and turn left (west) on SR 124. Go through Mt. Etna (Approx 6 miles) and continue on SR 124 across SR 9. Go 0.4 mile beyond SR 9 and turn right at Mt. Etna S.R.A. sign. Go 0.3 miles and turn left on the first road beyond the trailer park to the parking lot. Meet at 9:30 AM for approx. 20 mile hike. Bring lunch & water. (M,NS,3). Leader: Karleen Huneck (1-453-4270)

- OCT 6 (Sunday) (A) SHADES & BEYOND - Allow 1-1/2 hour travel from west side of Indy. Take I-74 west to Jamestown exit. Go through Jamestown and follow SR 234 west to the Park (Fee). Meet at 9:00 AM for a 15 to 17 mile hike in the Park and beyond. Meet in the picnic area at the end of the road to the left past the gatehouse. Moderate to rugged and some off trail. Bring lunch & water. (M,NS/PS,3). Leader: Al Dreho1 (898-363)
- (B) CATARACT FALLS FESTIVAL - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel. Take I-70 west to the Cloverdale exit. Go south on US 231 about 7 miles to the sign for Cataract Falls S.R.A. Turn right and go about 3 miles to the entrance. Meet at 9:30 AM for an easy to moderate hike of 7 miles. We will eat lunch in the village where a festival is in progress. Go 3 miles, turn right on Mississinewa Road. After 1 mile continue straight onto 900-S (Mississinewa Road curves sharply to the right). Go 0.8 mile on 900-S and meet at the Frances Slocum Cemetery on the left. I.H.C. signs will be posted. Hike will start at 9:00 AM. Bring lunch & water for a 16 mile hike. (M,HS,3). - (B) WESTWOOD COUNTRY CLUB - Meet at the Westwood Country (485-4619 Night Club at 10:00 AM for an easy 5 to 6 mile hike. Westwood is on High School Road north of 10th St. From 6200 West 10th (just east of I-465) go north on Vinewood 1/2 block High School Road. Turn left and go north to the Club. Go 5 miles thru Jalapa, over the river and park on the right. 10 to 12 mile hike to start at 9:00 AM. Bring lunch & water. (NOTE: "Mississinewa 1812" will be held on Sat & Sun 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM - a living history tribute to the life & times of early Indiana). (F,HS,3). - (B) MARIAN COLLEGE FALL COLORS - Meet at the Major Taylor Velodrome gravel parking lot, 3649 Cold Spring Road at 9:30 AM for a 5 to 6 mile hike. (F,HS/PS,3). Leaders: Don & Barbara Tipton (241-7953)

- OCT 19 (Saturday) (A) THREE LAKES TRAIL - Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at the sign for Morgan-Monroe Forest and go about 4 miles to the entrance. Turn left and go to the Cherry Lake Shelter (Watch for signs). Meet at 9:00 AM for a 10 mile hike. (M,NS,3). Leader: A.T. Mulberry (291-9979).
(B) FOX ISLAND NATURE PRESERVE - Take I-69 north to exit 102 (US 24 West). Go west and turn left at the first stop light (0.2 mile). This is Ellison Road. Follow this for almost 2 miles to the Nature Preserve sign. Allow 2 hours travel from I-465 and I-69. Meet in the parking lot at the Nature Center for a moderate hike of 3, 5, or 8 to 9 miles, starting at 10:40 AM (not a typo). Bring lunch & water. Rest rooms available. (F,PS/NS,2.5). - OCT 20 (Sunday) (A) NEW PALESTINE HIKE - Allow $\frac{1}{2}$ hour travel from I-465. Go east on Brookville Road. (US 52) for approx 9 miles and turn south (right) on Gem Road (~~Yellow-Flasher~~ or stop light). Go $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to entrance to New Palestine High School. Turn left and go to north end of Parking lot for a 16 to 17 mile hike starting at 8:00 AM. (F,PS,3.5). Leader: Rick Kinnaman (861-3979). 7:00
(B) GALLIVANTIN' THRU OLD GREENWOOD - Park at the far southwest corner of Greenwood Park Mall beyond Kohls and Children's Palace. Use Frye Road Entrance. Hike of 6 to 8 miles to start at 1:00 PM. Take I-65 south to the Seymour exit west. Go west on US 50 through Browns-town to SR 135 south. Go south 9.1 miles and turn left just after the Muscatatuck river bridge.
