Turn left and go about 5 miles to fire tower parking lot for a moderate hike of 6 miles and a moderate to rugged hike of 10-12 miles starting at 10:00AM. Longer hikers bring lunch & water. ORIENTEERING CLASS - A class is being sponsored by the Wilderness Club to provide hikers with the practical skills needed to navigate through wilderness areas using map, compass, and observation of the terrain. QUESTIONNAIRE - Thank you! Your response has been helpful. 95% of you find trail hikes to be great or enjoyable. 80% really like backwoods, while 75% really enjoy historic and wildflower hikes. 73% enjoy towpath-railway hiking. Shopping malls are a big turn-off! Most of you prefer a hiking speed of 3 miles per hour and like to hike 1-2 times a month or 1-2 times a week. A hike length of 5-7 miles is most popular, but hikes ranging from 8 to 12 miles are a close second. The desired length for the longer hikes is 15-18 miles. Most of you prefer to travel no more than 50 miles for a hike. Results will be posted at the IHC Christmas Party.

PRESIDENT'S CORNER - There are a couple of matters discussed by the board that I pass on to you.

Situations arise on hikes, particularly longer ones, where the leader can use some help. There may be an injury, or illness, or problems by a new hiker, or a trail problem that calls for assistance for the leader in charge. Members who are hesitant to volunteer to lead a hike can serve as a co-leader to fill this need. Please notify either me or the pathfinder, Don Tipton, if you can help.

Don Tipton is now busy working on filling the schedule for 1993. Hike leaders can be a great help to him by submitting their hikes for next year now. This will ease the problem of completing schedules at the last minute. This will also assure you as hike leader of getting the dates that are convenient to you.

Estella Perkins, membership officer, has asked that hike leaders check legibility of signatures on sign up sheets, and print in same if necessary before mailing to her. She has also requested multiple columns for multiple distance hikes.
