- AUG 1 (SUN - 2:00 PM) GREENWOOD - "SUBURBAN" - Take US 31 south to Greenwood Park Mall between County Line Rd and Fry Rd. Turn right (west) at Dairy Queen onto Main Street. Go approx 1/4 mile past cemetery to bottom of hill. Turn right into West Park lot. Meet at 2:00 PM for easy 5-6 mile hike. (F,PS/NS,3). Leader: Frank Burnett (888-7035)
- 3 (TUE - 9:30 AM) (A) PLAINFIELD - Take I-70 west to the Plainfield exit. Turn right on SR 267 to first stop light. Turn left on 600-S and go to first stop sign (Center St). AUG 14 (SAT - 9:00 AM) ONE & FOUR LAKES HIKE - Allow 1-1/2 hours travel. Take SR 37 south to about 4 miles south of Martinsville. Turn left at Morgan-Monroe sign and go about 4 miles to forest entrance. Turn left and go about 5 miles to the fire tower lot for moderate hikes of 5-6 or 12-15 miles starting at 9:00 AM. Bring wieners, buns, and drinks for a wiener roast. Shorter hikers will transfer the food and have hot coals ready when the longer hikers reach Bryant Creek shelter.
