- CT 1 (SAT - 10:00 AM) (A) BEARS OF BLUE RIVER FAIR - Sponsored by Shelbyville National Society. Allow 45 minutes travel. Take I-74 southeast to Shelbyville exit SR #9, and follow SR 9 into the circle downtown. Turn right on Washington St. Go 1-1/2 blocks and turn left into lot across from hospital. Park in back of lot. - OCT 9 (SUN - 2:00 PM) TURKEY RUN STATE PARK - Allow 2 hours travel. Take I-74 west to the Jamestown exit, then SR 234 west to SR 47. Turn left and go 14 miles to the Park (fee) Park in the Inn lot for a moderate 6 to 7 mile hike. Join us in eating at the Inn after the hike. (M,NS,3). Leader: Jean Ballinger (882-4760).

Go east on SR 32 two miles to Anderson Metropolitan Airport. Turn right onto airport entrance road. Go past terminal building and park in lot at south end of road. Meet at 2:00 PM for easy to moderate 7 mile hike with a 3 mile option. (F,NS/PS,3). Leader: Frank Burnett (888-7035)
- OCT 16 (SUN - 9:30 AM) (A) FALLS OF OHIO - Allow 2 hours travel from I-465. Take I-65 south to Clarksville (exit 0). Turn west on Market St. and go about 1 mile to parking area on left. (Approx 0.2 miles past R.R. bridge. The morning hike of 7 miles will start at 9:30 AM and will cross the Clark Memorial Bridge into Louisville and explore the riverfront area. We will eat on the largest exposed fossil beds in the world. The afternoon hike of 6 miles will begin at 1:00 PM and will include historic sites near the shoreline of the Ohio River in Jeffersonville. Bring lunch and water. (F,PS,3). The morning hike of 8 - 10 miles will begin at 9:00 AM and the afternoon hike of 5 - 6 miles will begin at 12:30 PM (depending on when the morning hike finishes). Those taking both hikes will need to bring lunch & water. There will be shorter hikes available, so come down and enjoy the beauty of Brown County at Gnow Bone whether you hike or not. (M,NS,3).
