HIKERS ARE URGED TO ARRIVE AT THE HIKE MEETING AREA AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE THE STARTING TIME. THIS WILL ENABLE THE LEADER TO COMPLETE SIGN-UP AND TO START THE HIKE ON TIME

SELF-GUIDED HIKEs: The Board of Directors wish to restate some of the rules for Self-Guided hikes as approved in June 1985 and published at that time. Hikers must sign the hike roster BEFORE hiking. Leaders of self-guided hikes have the same responsibility as leaders on other hikes to sign the roster and attest to the mileage. NO CREDIT is to be given for mileage hiked before signing the roster. These hikes are based on the honor system and it is up to each hiker to report to the leader any difference in mileage than what was signed up for. We urge everyone to hike as much as they want, but if you desire Club mileage, please follow the rules.

- X 1 (SAT - 9:30 AM) MUSCATATUCK NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE - Allow 2 hours travel. Take I-65 south to US 50 (east) exit at Seymour. Go east on US 50 about 3 miles to the entrance. Meet at the Visitor Center just inside on the right at 9:30 AM for hikes of 6, 11, or 15 miles. Bring lunch & water for longer hikes. (F,HS,3). Leader: Bill Larrison (359-7538)
