Bring your map and check it often. Take SR 37 south to Bloomington, then SR 45 southwest to SR 58 to US 231. South on US 231 about 5 miles (Farlen) where you will pick up SR 58 again. Turn west on SR 58 through Odon to CR 500E (flasher). Watch for signs to take you to Epsom. 10 milers will start from the Gainey home - a white frame, top of hill on west side of road - (balloons on mailbox # 106). House is about 3 miles south from last turn-off. 10 mile hike to start at 1:00 PM. The 6 mile hikers will continue on past the Gainey house - still following the signs to Epsom (driving around on gravel roads). Epsom is only 2 miles from the Gainey home. Park on street near the Epsom United Methodist Church. 6 mile hike to start at 2:00 PM.
