HIKERS ARE URGED TO ARRIVE AT THE MEETING AREA AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE THE STATED STARTING TIME. THIS WILL ENABLE THE LEADER TO COMPLETE SIGN UP AND START THE HIKE ON TIME.

- JUN 1 (SUN - 9:00 AM) (A) HEMLOCK CLIFFS - Allow 3 hours travel. Join us for a 12-mile hike in a beautiful area of caverns and rock formations. Go south on SR 37 past Grantsburg to the Blue River (unmarked). Bridge is a low concrete bridge, 1/2 mile beyond Grantsburg. Turn right (west) on Union Chapel Road (may not be marked), the first road one mile south of Blue River just before the end of the new portion of SR 37. (If you get to I-64, turn back). Go 2.6 miles on Union Chapel to a fork. Keep right on the gravel road for 3.4 miles to the second "Y," Hemlock Cliffs fork. Keep right on the small paved road to the parking lot. (TUE - 6:00 PM) (B) WARREN CENTRAL - From 21st St. and Post Rd., go east to street just before Warren Library. Turn right (S), go to the "T" and park in lot almost behind Walker Career Center for a 3 or 7 mile self-guided* hike. Repeats each Tuesday in June. (F,PS) Leader: Rick Kinnaman (861-3979)

Pass by the DNR entrance, drive over the dam, and turn right at the Observation Mound sign. Park in the lower lot for a moderate, possibly muddy, 15-mile hike with a 12-mile option. Turn left (E) on SR 244 and go approximately 8 miles to road on right, marked Moscow. In Moscow, before crossing covered bridge, turn right and go one block to church parking lot on left. Hike of 6.2 miles may be repeated if you want to do 12 miles. Self-guided.* (F, HS/PS) Sponsor: John V. Behrmann (462-7058)
- JUN 29 (SUN - 8:00 AM to 12:00 NOON) (A) EAGLE CREEK CLEAN-UP - Park where convenient. Meet at the NW corner of parking lot just inside the 56th Street entrance. Identify yourself as "IHC Clean-up Crew" and there will be no fee. We will hike to the clean-up site, picking up (trash, not speed) as we go. Trash bags will be furnished. Wear grubby clothes and bring work gloves and WATER. If you need to come later, ask at the gatehouse for an IHC map to the work site. Think of this as a small pay-back for the pleasure and exercise we have enjoyed in the park. Only about 4 to 5 miles of hiking so we can save our energy for the clean up. See you there! Fishing... No license is needed within the boundaries of the national park or the pay lake nearby. For Nolin Lake (north of the park), a license is required; boat rental is available there also.
