- AUG 2 (SAT - 9:00 AM) (A) GREEK ORTHODOX CHURCH - Park along east side of Pennsylvania just north of 40th Street for a 7 mile hike. (F,PS,3-3.5) Leader: Michele Kestle (251-7157)
(SAT - 9:30 AM) (B) TURKEY RUN STATE PARK - Take I-74 west to exit 52 (Jamestown). Go south on SR 75 through Jamestown, west on SR 234 and southwest on SR 47 to the park (fee). Meet near swimming pool for a hike of 5-6 miles on easy to moderate trails. (M, NS,2.5-3) Leader: Marsha Hutchins (251-9078)
- AUG 3 (SUN - 7:00 AM) (A) RUSHVILLE COVERED BRIDGES - Allow 1 1/2 hours from I-465 and SR 52 East. Take SR 52 east to Rushville. Meet on the north side of the courthouse for a 15-16 mile hike to 2 covered bridges. Bring water. (F,PS,3.5) Leader: Rick Kinnaman (861-3979)

- AUG 16 (SAT - 8:30 AM) (A) THREE STATE HIKE - Take I-69 north to Exit 154 (Angola) and follow SR 127 north to SR 120. Turn right (east) and go 3 miles to Fremont Elementary School. Allow 3 1/4 hours travel. Meet promptly at 8:30 AM to drive to Park Point. This will be about a 20-mile road hike to the triple point where Indiana, Ohio, and Michigan meet and around Clear Lake. Bring lunch and water. Contact hike leader if you wish to stay over for Sunday's Chain O' Lakes hike--camping and motels available in area. (F,PS,3.5) Leader: Rick Kinnaman (861-3979)
(SAT - 10:00 AM) (B) POTATO CREEK STATE PARK VOLKSMARCH - Allow at least 2 hours travel time. Take US 31 north toward South Bend, going past Plymouth and on to Lakeville. Just beyond Lakeville, turn west (L) on SR 4 and go 3-4 miles to Potato Creek (fee). Meet at Nature Center for this 6 or 12-mile self-guided* Volksmarch. Please advise hike leader of your intended mileage. Each hiker must have a "walk card" (free) to be stamped at checkpoints and turned in when hike is completed. - AUG 23 & 24 (SAT, SUN - 8:00 AM) KAL-HAVEN TRAIL STATE PARK - This 34-mile trail runs from Kalamazoo to South Haven, Michigan (a quaint lakeside town with good restaurants and a beach). Plan on parking in Bloomingdale, MI which is the halfway point, and doing a car shuttle both days. RECOMMENDED DIRECTIONS: Take SR 31 north from Indianapolis to the 20 E Bypass of South Bend (toward Mishawaka and Elkhart) to 13 N which becomes 131 N in Michigan. Stay on 131 all the way to the west side of Kalamazoo. Take M 43 west for about 16 miles, turn on County Road 665 N (the next flasher light after M 40). Stay on this road about 7 miles. You will be in Bloomingdale at a four-way stop. On your left, next to the old train depot, is the parking lot for the trail. Approximate driving time 4 3/4 to 5 hours. Plan to meet at 8:00 AM (Indianapolis time) both days. Saturday's hike will be 18 miles to South Haven. Sunday's hike will be 16 miles to Kalamazoo. Bring lunch and water both days, although there are refreshment stands along the way. Call the leaders for more information on camping, motels, wineries, micro-breweries, etc. in this area.
