HIKERS ARE URGED TO ARRIVE AT THE MEETING AREA AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE STATED TIME. THIS WILL ENABLE THE LEADER TO COMPLETE SIGN-UP AND START THE HIKE ON TIME.

When adverse weather conditions prevail to the extent that hiking or getting to a hike would be extremely hazardous, the leader has the authority to reroute, shorten, or cancel a hike. Hikes have rarely been canceled. Still it's a good idea to check with the leader ahead of time if the weather is severe.

- DEC 1 (TUE - 9:30 AM) (A) PLAINFIELD - Take I-70 west to Plainfield exit. Go north on SR 267 to first stop light. Turn left (W) on 600 S and go to first stop sign (Center Street). Turn right (N) and go 1/4 mile to Hummel Park. Meet at back of far west-side parking area near new restroom facility for a walk of 5-6 miles. Repeats December 15 and 29.
