Once in the park, follow the red volksmarch signs 4 miles to the Recreation Building. Each hiker must have a walk card (free) to be stamped at the checkpoints and turned in at the starting desk when the 6 or 12 mile self-guided* hike is completed. Please remember to turn in your walk card after the hike or volksmarch members will go out on the trail looking for you. Cross the bridge and follow SR 1 to Blooming Grove. Turn left (east on Fairfield Road (yellow flasher)). Cross Fairfield causeway and park in first lot immediately after crossing the lake.
