HIKERS ARE URGED TO ARRIVE AT THE MEETING AREA AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE STATED TIME. THIS WILL ENABLE THE LEADER TO COMPLETE SIGN-UP AND START THE HIKE ON TIME. When adverse weather conditions prevail to the extent that hiking or getting to a hike would be extremely hazardous, the leader has the authority to reroute, shorten, or cancel a hike. It is a good idea to check with the leader ahead of time if the weather is severe.
