- JUN 1 (SUN 9:30 AM) SOUTHEASTWAY PARK (NOTE: There is construction on I-74, so you might want to take the following route.) Go southeast on US 52 (Brookville Road) to Carroll Road (stoplight) on the Marion-Hancock county line. Turn right and go 3.2 miles to the park entrance. Meet at the Activity Center lot for a hike of 5 miles. (F,NS/PS,2.5-3) Leader: Marsha Hutchins (251-9078)
(SUN 12:30 PM) TURKEY RUN STATE PARK Take I-74 west to the Jamestown exit. Go through Jamestown and follow SR 234 west to SR 47. Turn left on SR 47 and go 14 miles to the park (fee). Meet in lodge parking lot for an 8-mile hike with shorter options. Watermelon provided by hike leaders for seed spitting contest after the hike. (SUN 1:00 PM) DEVONSHIRES Meet near Cord Camera in Lakewood Village shopping mall on the southeast corner of 71st Street and SR 37 for a 6-mile walk. (F,PS,3.5) Leader: Michele Kestle (251-7157)
- JUN 2 (MON 8:30 AM) ZOO & CANAL Meet in the southeast corner of the Zoo parking lot for a 6-mile hike. Repeats June 16 & 30, July 14. (F,PS,3.5) Leader: Rick Peck (291-4873)

* SELF-GUIDED HIKEs: Self-guided hikes are intended to allow you to walk at your own speed. Your leader is obligated only to sign you up and furnish you a map or instructions. If you do not want to walk alone, a good idea would be to plan for a partner ahead of time.

(MON 9:00 AM) TOWPATH TO BUTLER Meet in the free parking lot that is ½ block south of Broad Ripple Ave. on Carrollton Ave. (one short block east of College) for a 6 mile hike. Repeats June 30. (F,HS,3) Leader: Cherie Voege (848-7674)
(MON 6:00 PM) BROAD RIPPLE Meet in the free lot ½ block south of Broad Ripple Avenue on Carrollton (one short block east of College) for a 6-mile self-guided* hike. Repeats June 30 & July 7. (F,HS) Leader: Stephanie Kestle (706-1726)

JUN 3 (TUE 9:00 AM) FORT HARRISON & SKILES TEST NATURE PARK Go east on 56th St. and north on Post Rd. Turn left to enter park (fee). Meet at Cherry Tree parking area for a walk of 6-7 miles with shorter options. Repeats July 29. (F,NS/PS,3) Leader: Dick Underwood (506-0924)
(TUE 9:00 AM) SHORT EAGLE CREEK TRAIL HIKE Meet in Lilly Lake parking lot for a 4-mile hike. From 71st Street gatehouse (fee) go straight, then turn left on the first street (opposite the Nature Center entrance). Turn right at the first opportunity and then right again at the T. Follow this road until you come to the parking lot on the left, across from and east of Lilly Lake. Repeats June 17, July 8 & 22. (M,NS,3-3.5) Leaders: Marian and/or Bob Corya (297-3926)
(TUE 9:30 AM) HOT DAY SLOW HIKE AT HOLLIDAY PARK Park is located in 6300 block of Spring Mill Rd. Meet at north end of Nature Center lot for a hike of 4-5 miles (shorter options) Repeats July 8. (M,NS/PS, 2-2.5) Leader: Marsha Hutchins (251-9078)
(TUE 4:30 PM) 91st AND MONON TRAIL Meet in the parking area adjacent to the Monon Trail on 91st Street located between College and Westfield Blvd. The parking lot is approximately 10 blocks east of Meridian Street. (TUE 6:00 PM) BEECH GROVE Meet at southeast corner of Emerson and Churchman in Beech Grove (near Krogers) for a 5 mile self-guided* hike. (F,PS) Repeats each Tuesday in June. Leader: Ricki Jo Hoffmann (782-8147)

JUN 4 (WED 8:00 AM) BRISK WALK IN THE WOODS Meet in lot just inside 56th Street entrance (fee) for an 8-mile hike. Repeats each Wednesday in June and July. (M,NS,3.5-4) Leader: Rick Peck (291-4873).
(WED 8:30 AM) PRESIDENTS' PROMENADE/WASHINGTON SQUARE Use mall entrance nearest MCL Cafeteria for a self-guided* walk in the mall. Sign-in sheet is on clipboard in front of MCL window. You may take as many one-mile laps as you wish for your desired mileage. Repeats each Wednesday in June. (F,PS) Leader: Bob Pedigo (891-1943)
(WED 6:00 PM) DOWNTOWN O'MALIA'S Meet in northeast corner of O'Malia's lot (320 N. New Jersey) for a self-guided* walk of 5-6 miles. Repeats each Wednesday in June. (F,PS) Leader: Avis Shipman (271-1442 days and 745-2764 evenings)

JUN 5 (THU 8:30 AM) INDY'S BEST KEPT SECRET 7 mile hike in Town Run Trail Park. Indy Parks' hidden jewel hiking/biking trail along the White River. Park entrance (look for sign) is located on the south side of 96th St., 0.6 mile west of Allisonville Rd. Trail has numerous short hills. Trail gets muddy after a heavy rain, so consider hiking boots. Bring water since there is none on the trail. Repeats June 17 and July 28. (M,NS,3.5) Leader: Ed Wright (578-9026)
(THU 9:30 AM) EASY AT EAGLE CREEK Meet at amphitheater lot in Eagle Creek Park (fee) for a user-friendly hike of 5-6 miles with shorter options. Repeats each Thursday in June and July. (M,NS,2-3) Leader Bill Larrison (388-0498)
(THU 6:00 PM) ELLENBERGER PARK Meet in lot near swimming pool at Ellenberger Park (5400 E. St Clair & 800 N. Ritter) for a 5-6 mile hike. Repeats each Thursday in June. (F,PS,3-3.5) Leader: Rick Kinnaman (861-3979)

JUN 6 (FRI 8:00 AM) BRISK ROAD HIKE - EAGLE CREEK Meet in lot just inside 56th St. entrance (fee). Repeats each Friday in June and July, except July 4. (M,PS,3.5) Leaders: Elaine Wright (573-4919 ext. 17 days) & Fran Leone (849-7006)

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(FRI 8:30 AM) CASTLETON MALL WALK Meet in food court near Galyans on the north side of Castleton Square for a self-guided walk of one-mile laps for your desired mileage. Repeats each Friday in June and July. (F,PS) Leader: Tom Patterson (849-9528)

(FRI 6:00 PM) OVER, AROUND, & THROUGH IUPUI Meet in Shapiro's Deli/Cafeteria lot, 808 S. Meridian, for a 6-mile self-guided* walk. Repeats each Friday in June. (F,PS) Leader: Jim Griffin (359-9371)

JUN 7 (SAT 9:00 AM) MISSISSINEWA LAKE Allow 80 minutes from Meridian/US31 exit of I-465. Follow US 31 north to just past Grissom Air Force Base. Turn right on CR 500 South. Continue east 8.4 miles and turn left into Miami State Recreation Area. Follow signs for 1.5 miles to beach parking lot. Bring water and lunch for this 15-mile road hike which follows the northern route of the American Discovery Trail. Note that the water level is down to allow remediation of the dam's foundation. A rare chance to walk in the lake and see the original river valley. (M,PS,3.5) Leader: Tom Kapostasy (575-0768)

(SAT 9:30 AM) NEWCOMERS' HIKE Meet in the parking lot at Spiece at the corner of 73rd and Keystone for a 6-mile hike with a 3-mile option. (F,P,3) Leaders: Betty Steed (251-8210) and Cherie Voege (848-7674)

(SAT 10:00 AM) BIG TREE Approximately 50 miles from I-465 to church parking. Take I-74 east to exit 134B which is IND. 3 north. Exit 134A for restrooms. No restroom on hike. Go north on IND. 3 approximately 3 miles to County Rd. 500 N. Turn right, go 4 miles to "T" then left on 400 E. Proceed 2½ miles to "T" at 640 N. Park in Presbyterian Church Parking lot. 7-mile hike with a look at the biggest MAGNOLIA TREE in Indiana. (F,HS/PS,3-3.5) Leader: Phillip Short (856-7598)

JUN 8 (SUN 9:00 AM) HIKE AROUND EAGLE CREEK Follow west 56th Street across causeway west of Eagle Creek Park. Turn north immediately into the fisherman's parking lot beside the large iron sculpture of a bear. This will be an 11-mile hike around Eagle Creek Reservoir. The west side can be rugged in places and it may be warm, so don't forget to bring water. (M,NS,3.5) Leader: Ed Wright (578-9026)

(SUN 9:30 AM) LIEBER STATE RECREATION AREA Allow 1½ hours travel. Take I-70 west to exit for SR 243. Go south to the park (fee). Meet in picnic area which is the left fork at the top of the hill just before going down to the beach area. There will be a 5-7 mile hike with shorter options. (M,NS,2.5-3) Leader: Bill Larrison (388-0498)

(SUN 2:00 PM) NOBLESVILLE VOLKSMARCH From SR37 northbound, turn left on 191st Street. Follow 191st Street to Allisonville Road. Turn right on Allisonville Road. Meet at Potter Bridge Park which will be on the left approximately three blocks, for a 6-mile walk. Each hiker should have a free "walk card" to be stamped at checkpoints and turned in when hike is completed. We may participate in the Volksmarch at no charge, however donations are appreciated. (F,PS/HS) Leader: Cherie Voege (848-7674)

JUN 9 (MON 8:00 AM) STEPPIN LIVELY AT EAGLE CREEK Meet in the 56th Street parking lot (fee) or you can park across the street at the corner of Reed Road and east 56th Street and walk in (fee). This will be a 9-mile hike with a 6-mile option. Repeats June 23 and July 21. (F,PS/NS,3.5-4) Leader: Rick Peck (291-4873)

(MON 9:30 AM) HIKE AND DELIGHT-VISIT AWARD WINNING HOSTA GARDENS Meet at 4131 Brown Rd. (Brown Rd. runs north and south and is between Emerson and Sherman.) Take 42nd St. to Brown Rd. and go south on Brown Rd. Park on street for a 5-6 mile walk with shorter option. We will return at 11:30 (for those who would like to take the tour, but do not wish to hike, you can join us at this time) for a charming tour of an award winning Hosta Garden. Bathroom break at the end of the walk. (F,PS,2.5-3) Leader: Pat Lawler (329-2779)

(MON 6:00 PM) BROAD RIPPLE Meet in free parking lot that is ½ block south of Broad Ripple Avenue on Carrollton Avenue for a hike of 5-6 miles. (Carrollton is one short block east of College.) 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- JUN 10 (TUE 8:30 AM) LAKE CLEARWATER AND BEYOND This is a 6 mile hike around Lake Clearwater and nearby neighborhoods with an optional 4 mile add-on through Royal Pines. Turn south off 82nd St. onto Dean Rd about 0.8 mile east of Keystone Ave. Park in the northwest corner of Joe's Crabshack parking lot. Repeats June 24 and July 22.  (TUE 9:30 AM) HOT DAY SHORT HIKE AT EAGLE CREEK Meet at the amphitheater lot in Eagle Creek Park (fee) for a hike of 4-5 miles (shorter options) Repeats June 24 and July 29. (M,NS/HS/PS, 2-2.5) Leader: Marsha Hutchins (251-9078)
 (TUE 4:30 PM) 91ST AND MONON TRAIL See June 3.

 (THU 9:30 AM) EASY AT EAGLE CREEK See June 5.
 (THU 6:00PM) ELLENBERGER PARK See June 5.
- JUN 13 (FRI 8:00 AM) BRISK ROAD HIKE - EAGLE CREEK See June 6.
 (FRI 8:30 AM) CASTLETON MALL WALK See June 6.
 (FRI 6:00 PM) OVER, AROUND, & THROUGH IUPUI See June 6.
- JUN 14 (SAT 9:00 AM) DOWNTOWN GARDEN HIKE Meet in the NE corner of O'Malia's parking lot at 320 N. New Jersey Street for an 8-mile hike through downtown neighborhoods. This is a garden HIKE, not a garden TOUR. We will not be able to enter private property, and the extent of horticultural analysis will be to say "See the pretty flowers" when we pass an attractive garden.  (SAT 9:00 AM) PIONEER PARK AND STRAWBERRY FESTIVAL From southwest leg of I-465, take SR 67 southwest for 7 miles to sign - HOME OF THE STATE FLAG in Mooresville. Turn right and go to Indianapolis Road (about 1 mile) and turn right. Go to 1st entrance to Pioneer Park on right (about 1 mile). After 5-6 mile hike you may want to have lunch at Mooresville's Strawberry Festival at the Methodist Church across from the park (B-B-Q and bake sale).  (SAT 9:30 AM) WABASH & ERIE CANAL AT DELPHI Allow 80 minutes from northeast side of Indianapolis. Take I-65 past Lafayette to SR 25. Turn right toward Delphi (exit 175). Meet at Trailhead Park on west side of SR 25 (about 1 miles south of Delphi). Hike 9 miles of interesting paths and views with a 3 or 5 mile option. There is one hill and some steps with 2 miles of paved surface. Bring water for hike and lunch for after hike. (F,HS/PS,3) Leader: Dick Underwood (506-0924)
- JUN 15 (SUN 10:00 AM) CANAL WALK Meet in northeast corner of O'Malia's lot (320 N. New Jersey) for a 5-mile walk on the canal and along White River. Two bathroom breaks. (F,PS,2.5-3) Leader: Marthene Kohlmeyer (849-5051)
 (SUN 2:00 PM) CROWN HILL Walk through Crown Hill - see Dillinger's grave and up Riley Hill. Park in lot by Hinkle field house at Butler in south east corner. 6 miles, first half guided, second half self-guided. Repeats July 12. (H,PS,3-3.5) Leader: Anna Buckholz (271-6730 or 371-8797)
- JUN 16 (MON 8:30 AM) ZOO & CANAL See June 2.
 (MON 9:00 AM) DRIVE YOUR CHEVY TO THE LEVEE AND TAKE A HIKE Meet in the east end of Marsh's parking lot in the Speedway Shopping Center (on the south side of Crawfordsville Road) for a 6-mile hike on the Eagle Creek Levee. (F,PS/HS,2.5-3) Leader: Pat Lawler (329-2779)
 (MON 6:00 PM) BROAD RIPPLE See June 9.

- JUN 21,22 (SAT,SUN) INDIANA DUNES NATIONAL LAKESHORE PARK AND STATE PARK, CHESTERTON Allow 3 hours (160 miles) from I-865 connector to I-65 on northside of Indy. Take I-65 north (135 miles) to exit 259-B, I-80/94 east. Stay on I-94 east (I-80 splits off) about 13 miles to exit 26-B, Chesterton, SR 49. To access National Lakeshore Park, go north on SR 49 about ½ mile then west on U.S. 20 for 1.3 miles to Mineral Springs Road. Watch for sign for *Bailly/Chellberg Farm*. Turn right. Parking lot is .1 mile on left. Dunes State Park Entrance is at the end of SR 49, about 2.5 miles north of I-94. *Bring plenty of water, insect repellent and sunscreen.* Note: Chesterton is on Indy time.  (SAT 9:30 AM) INDIANA DUNES NATIONAL LAKESHORE PARK, COWLES BOG TRAIL Meet in Billy/Cellberg parking lot (restrooms & picnic area). We will carpool to trailhead. This 4-5 mile hike will include dunes, woods and beach. If you are staying for the afternoon hike, bring lunch. (H,NS,2.5-3)
 (SAT 1:00 PM) INDIANA DUNES NATIONAL LAKESHORE PARK, BAILLY HOMESTEAD & CEMETERY, CHELLBERG FARM, AND LITTLE CALUMET RIVER TRAILS Meet in Bailly/Chellberg parking lot (restrooms & picnic area) for a 5-6 mile hike. (M,NS,2.5-3)
 (SUN 10:15 AM) INDIANA DUNES STATE PARK (fee) Meet in the Nature Center parking lot (Nature Center/restrooms open at 10:00 am) for an 8-9 mile hike with a 5-6 mile option. Both hikes include woods, 2 miles of sand dunes and a picnic on the beach. Long hike includes additional beach walk. (M,NS,2.5-3)
- JUN 21 (SAT 9:30 AM) ZIONSVILLE Meet in lot south of Friendly Tavern on Main Street in Zionsville for a 5-mile walk. (F,PS,3.5) Leader: Michele Kestle (251-7157)
